The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside hereby enacts as follows:
RESIDENTIAL CARD REGULATIONS
Authority: Riverside County Ordinance No. 779 23. These regulations shall apply to all residential self-haul cards issued at the Oasis Landfill.

- 1. Number of Uses: The number of uses will be limited to one (1) use per household.
2. Expiration Date: The expiration date for the card shall be one (1) year from the date of issuance.
3. No Refunds: There are no refunds for the card.
4. Standard Load: The standard load shall be limited to the equivalent of four (4) cubic yards of material.
5. Payment Options: Cards may be purchased monthly, quarterly, or annually.

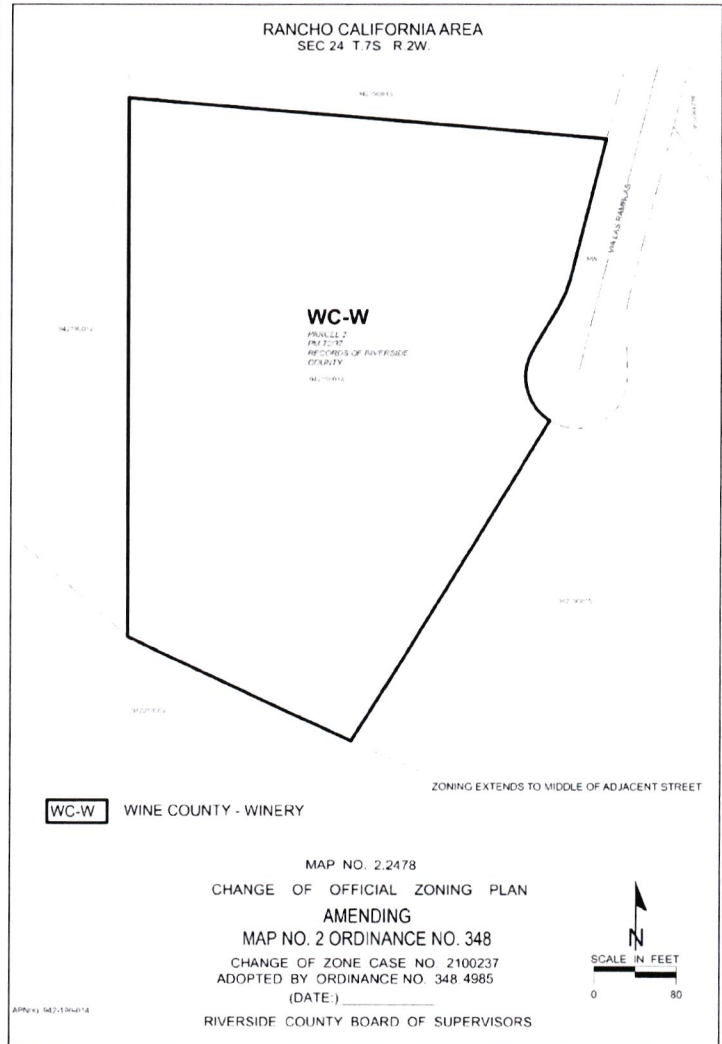
