BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Studio 395 \$3,000 funding will be used to support neighborhood and roadside cleanup efforts provided by residents in the Lakeland Village community.
- 2. Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, Inc. \$1,000 funding will be used to support the 2023 Housing Conference. This conference will bring together decision-makers in order to solve Fair Housing issues in Riverside County.
- 3. Dresses & Dreams Project \$1,000 funding will be used to support efforts to provide dresses to local high school girls that are going through hardships or circumstances which leave then unable to purchase a formal dress and accessories to attend their prom. 100-120 girls are expected to sign for assistance this year.
- **4. Vision to Learn \$1,000** funds will be used to support efforts to provide school-based eye exams and glasses to students in the Mead Valley and Good Hope communities.
- **5.** California Trail Users Coalition- \$7,600 funds will be used to support a nonprofit's efforts to repair and reopen Indian truck Trail in the Cleveland National Forest.
