#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary**

This item is for the purpose of establishing Central Mail Service rates for FY 23/24.

Central Mail operates as an Internal Service Fund (ISF) and recovers its operating costs through charges to its customers. Central Mail rates include the cost of providing interoffice mail delivery and pickup from departments as well as the processing of letters, flats, packaging, and other specialty items through the United States Postal Service (USPS). The Central Mail facility is located on Washington Street in Riverside with a satellite office in the Riverside County Administrative Center for collection and distribution of mail.

The FY 23/24 metered mail rates remain the same as the current FY 22/23 rates, as volume is anticipated to remain consistent. Postal charges are a pass-thru expense and based on estimated usage; therefore, any departmental increase is based on current trends. Departments are billed actuals.

The FY 23/24 delivery rates per mail stop will remain the same as the current FY 22/23 rates. There has been no significant change in the total number of mail stops in the County.
