



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Palm Springs Health Run & Wellness Festival will be held on Saturday, January 28, 2023 at Ruth Hardy Park in Palm Springs. The event will provide a health and fitness-oriented routine. In addition, more than 100 health and wellness booths will provide resources and services, rock climbing wall, walk on water and more. CID funds will help cover expenses of the event.

2. The Palm Springs Air Museum will host their Women in Aviation 2023 Annual Gala on February 18, 2023. This event raises funds for their Commemorative Educational Programs which supports educational, cultural, and historical significance programs which takes place inside the Miles Hanger.

3. UC Riverside, Chicano Studies Program (CSP) serves the Chicano Latino population at UCR by providing support services and facilitating programs. CSP recently celebrated their 50th Anniversary Gala, to raise funds for scholarships and serve as a medium for networking. CID funds will be utilized to support CSP programs and services.
