#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary**

On May 25, 2021, Item 3.13, the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved in-principle the RUHS-ITF ETS Triage Intake T.I. Project and the preliminary project budget in the amount of \$143,810 to screen patients, collect patient information and provide safe exit pathways for emergency situations to comply with safety concerns and Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) regulations.

On May 25, 2021, the Purchasing Agent approved Purchase Order (P.O.) FMARC-0000096503, in the amount of \$38,879 between the County of Riverside (County) and Sudweeks Construction, Inc. (Sudweeks), a pre-approved county contractor. During the course of construction, five (5) Change Orders were approved for additional Fiberglass Reinforced Panels (FRP) for the adjacent interview rooms and the reception desk; unforeseen electrical and framing changes per the California Department of Health Care Access and Information, additional data drops, casework changes, and new ceiling tiles in the triage area. Seeking competitive bids for the additional work would not produce an advantage and is impractical for the work. The increase to the P.O. will compensate Sudweeks in the additional amount of \$30,883, for a new contract P.O. value of \$69,762.

Facilities Management is seeking Board approval for additional funds not to exceed \$44,897 for a revised project budget in the amount of \$188,707. The additional funds will cover the additional work performed by Sudweeks and to cover other obligations to complete the Project.

### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The RUHS-ITF ETS Triage Intake T.I. Project will enhance staff and patient safety and comply with current COVID-19 regulations and will help provide better services within the lobby area.
