2. Adopt a yearly presentation for Woman of the Year in honor of International Women's Day.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

In 1978, Women's History Week was acknowledged and began the implementation of Women's History in the educational curriculum. Ten years later, Congress announced the month of March to celebrate the economic, political, and social contributions of women. Each year, the theme of International Women's Day is a call to encourage the continuous advancement of women's achievements. This year, International Women's Day is held on March 8, 2023.

Throughout the County of Riverside, many industries such as education, government, labor, and non-profit organizations are led by women. This is an example of the importance of celebrating leaders throughout each Supervisorial District who works toward creating environments that are equitable, empowering, and serve our community. In honor of this day, each Supervisor shall select a Woman of the Year at the March 7, 2023, Board of Supervisor's Meeting who lives and/or works in the specified district. Supervisors may choose a selection of their choice or utilize an application with submittals from the community.

1. Requirement considerations are as follows:
 - a. The nomination must not come from an immediate family member.
 - b. Nominees must live or work in the Supervisorial District for which they have been nominated.

2. Should a submittal from the public be selected, an application and statement should be attached, not to exceed 1000 words which outline the following:
 - a. Outline the area(s) in which the nominee has made an important and noticeable contribution to her community by leading the way to make Riverside County a better place for women to reach their full potential.
 - b. Outline how the nominee is a valuable member of her organization of the program. In what ways did the nominee contribute to helping others and aiding her community?
 - c. Has the nominee been awarded or performed in any state programs, organizations, projects, or cumulative volunteer or professional achievements?
