

BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$2,500 - the funding will be used for the Chamber annual awards presentation that honors and supports exceptional businesses that demonstrate strong community involvement in the Temecula area.
2. Aguanga Christian Fellowship - \$51,358 - the funding will be utilized to assist with mitigation fees and completion of the Aguanga Christian Fellowship multi-purpose building that will serve the residents of Aguanga, Anza and Vail Lake area. The Aguanga Christian Fellowship provides drug and alcohol counseling, food and clothing distribution to individuals and families.
3. Community Mission of Hope – \$10,000 – the funding will be used to provide food, hygiene, and household items to over 500 at-risk families each month. In addition, Community Mission of Hope provides a Housing Resource Center that offers employment and housing support to those in need at the Center.
