BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Restoration Agape - \$500** funding will be used to support birthday celebrations for seniors at the Moses Schaffer Community Center.
2. **Hazel's Hands Inc. - \$1,500** funding will be used to support their efforts of providing new bedding, and new duffle bags to new and already placed foster youth.
3. **FitOne Foundation. - \$2,000** funding will be used to purchase equipment. FOF will be providing free health, fitness, and nutrition classes to at-risk and under-served youth in the First District.
4. **Riverside Downtown Partnership - \$800** funding will be used to support the Safety and Security Award at the 2023 Downtown Achievement Awards.
5. **Assistance League of Riverside - \$2,000** funding will be used to provide services to children in preschool to young adults in college, through their various programs.
