BACKGROUND:

Summary

Reaching New Heights Foundation Inc. (RNH), non-profit, assists veterans transitioning from active duty, incarceration, or homelessness. Services are provided through collaboration with local and government agencies to build pride and stability. RNH offers Veterans Court support, psychological therapy, counseling, job training, and various resources to make positive change in the lives of veterans.

This vehicle donation from the County of Riverside will help RNH with transportation services for veteran clients to the many services that support the needs of the veteran and help progress toward self-sufficiency.

This item authorizes the director of Purchasing and Fleet to work with other county departments to locate a suitable vehicle. The vehicle may come from Purchasing and Fleet's inventory, or the inventory of another department with suitable vehicles. The residual cost of surplus vehicles averages \$2,000 and is a cost to the department facilitating the donation.
