Richard spent much of his adult life in public service, starting with enlisting in the U.S. Army as a medic and serving in Vietnam in 1970. He would go on to work in the recycling industry, including founding Tri-CED Community, which is now California's largest nonprofit recycling organization.

Richard fought for safety-net services, mental health programs, at-risk youth, and job development programs. He supported Saint Rose Hospital and community volunteers.
