BACKGROUND:

Summary

Sheriff's Court Services (SCS) Division operates three stand-alone Business Offices, and these facilities are approaching 15+ years of continual services and are showing their age. The scope of work for the project included updating office areas to include replacing customer service windows, window coverings, flooring, and office furniture for the overall facility modernization. The existing carpet is severely aged and becoming unsafe. Furniture is being replaced to be compliant with ergonomic standards as well as modern safety standards. Painting throughout is requested as the walls are chipped, bubbled, discolored, and have moisture damage. This request for Courts also includes funding to update the kitchen as it needs to be brought up to code and some cabinets have fallen off the wall; the existing sink, and backsplash need to be replaced; the window coverings need to be replaced as they are discolored and damaged; and the existing customer service windows need to be removed and replaced. Additionally, the window glazing, and microphone/speaker need to be replaced as the existing one is antiquated.

In addition, the Sheriff's Department is seeking to replace/upgrade computer equipment due to age and data limitations at various sites. The current technology lacks features and capabilities to support software that has recently become web based.

These purchases are necessary to support the Department business offices located in Murrieta, Indio, and Riverside. Staff at the three offices provide specialized civil legal clerical support by preparing, processing, and tracking numerous civil legal actions, such as evictions, bankruptcies, small claims, summons and complaints, civil and criminal subpoenas, restraining orders, earning withholding orders, legal/court procedures or specific file notations through the entire civil process. In addition, the Sheriff is ordered by the court in many of the processes to seize cash, property or in the case of earnings withholdings, receive checks from employers then disburse the seized money to the proper client.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

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Citizens and businesses will benefit significantly by the timely replacement of equipment required for smooth daily operations. These purchases will also allow management, field investigations, and clerical staff to work and service customers efficiently. The projects are funded 100% by sub funds from fees already collected in the County, which facilitates the process and conserves the County general fund.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Department will use the Court Services Automation Fund for the Court Services purchases in the amount of \$826,000. As authorized by State Government Code Section 26731, counties shall deposit \$15 from specific fees collected by the Sheriff's Civil Courts Division to a special fund to supplement the cost for the purchase of auxiliary equipment and furnishings for automated systems or other nonautomated equipment and furnishings as required by the Civil Courts Division.

The purchase of all the products will be done through the awarded vendors, based on the County Purchasing policy and requirements.
