

**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

The Riverside County Children and Families Commission (RCCFC) was established by this Board in the adoption of Ordinance 784, enacted on January 22, 1999. The Commission implements the provisions of Proposition 10, which provides tobacco tax funds to facilitate the creation and implementation of an integrated, comprehensive, and collaborative system of information and services to enhance optimal early childhood development and to ensure that children are ready to enter school.

Angelica Hurtado has been an educator for 30 years. She has taught elementary school from K-5<sup>th</sup> and in bilingual classrooms. She is currently obtaining her doctorate degree from California Baptist University. Angelica has obtained her Master of Science in Education/Educational Leadership from California Baptist University.
