BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Beloved Foundation (BF) (\$3,000.00) will be used for their Family & Patient Assistance Grant Program. Beloved Foundation serves cancer patients and caregivers who struggle with the financial burden of a Stage IV or terminal Cancer diagnosis in the family. BF provides short-term financial grants, emotional support, and services, as well as resources.
2. The donation to the Kiwanis Club of Norco Foundation (\$4,000.00) will be used for their JFK and Norco High School Scholarships program. They work with two high schools in District 2 to award scholarships of \$500-\$1,000 to students based on various criteria. They award approximately 12 grants per year to assist students in either tuition, books, computers or other needs to pursue a degree from a college or university. They also provide funding for the ROTC at Norco High School.
3. The donation to the Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee (LEAC) (\$2,500.00) will be used for the Annual Law Enforcement Appreciation Dinner and Recognition Ceremony. LEAC's practice is to have each Honoree and guest attend without charge. In addition, LEAC also extends an invitation to family members of the Fallen Officers in Riverside County.
4. The donation to the Mary S. Roberts Pet Adoption Center (MSRPAC) (\$4,000.00) will be used for their Community Safety through Homeless Animal Care program. MSRPAC works closely with the Riverside County Department of Animal Services (RCDAS) helping them with overcrowding of animals. The funds will be used to also pay for

transfer fees and take cats and dogs from RCDAS to their center for imminent adoption. They microchip, spay/neuter, and provide all medical care and vaccines needed.

5. The donation to the American Cancer Society (\$3,000.00) will be used for the Relay for Life of Corona. Funding from this event helps fund cutting edge research, free patient programs, and education on cancer prevention and early detection.
6. The donation to the Riverside County Youth Commission (\$3,000.00) will be used for their 25th Annual Youth Summit. It will help fund this event which around 300 youth will be attending, and 15 community resources exhibitors will be present. The Youth Summit provides an opportunity for youth to say what information and topics are important to them and how we can help meet their needs by providing professional and resourceful speakers for them to learn from.
7. The donation to BLU Educational Foundation (\$2,000.00) will be used for the Positioned 2 Rise Youth Empowerment Conference. The conference focuses on teaching youth and their parent's financial literacy, wealth building, and entrepreneurship to help families position their children to rise above stereotypes, limiting beliefs, and other obstacles that may thwart plans for a successful financial and educational future.
