**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. LEAC – Law Enforcement Appreciation Ceremony - \$1,250.00 – The funding will be utilized for the annual appreciation awards ceremony, which recognizes volunteers, law enforcement agencies and citizens that serve Riverside County.
2. Mary S. Roberts Pet Adoption Center (MSRPAC) - \$5,000.00 – The MSRPAC is a continual community partner to Riverside County Department of Animal Services. MSRPAC serves several hundreds of animals each year. The funds will be primarily used for Spay/Neuter/Vaccine services for the residents of Riverside County and transfer fees from the Riverside County Department of Animal Services Shelter.
3. Riverside County Youth Commission - \$1,000.00 – The funding will be used to reimburse High Schools for the cost of transportation for 300 students to attend the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Youth Summit.
4. Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) - \$2,500.00 – The funds will be used for their fundraiser “Walk like MADD 5K”. The MADD program raises awareness to end drunk driving and to fight drug driving.
