

BACKGROUND:

Summary

In 2019, after significant rains, the Temescal Valley and Elsinore Valley of California experienced a Super Poppy Bloom. The native poppy flowers caused significant impacts on traffic flow along the 15 freeway and surrounding access roads. There were over 50,000 visitors during the Super Bloom period. This created traffic jams along the 15 freeway as well as public and private streets. Although a Super Bloom is not anticipated for the 2023 season the County of Riverside and City of Lake Elsinore are preparing for the potential onslaught of visitors to the area again. The Emergency Management Department is using the Reimbursable Letter of Agreement (Agreement) with the State of California Department of California Highway Patrol (CHP) to provide personnel with patrol vehicles for traffic enforcement in the Temescal Valley and Lake Elsinore areas, on an as-needed basis, in the 2023 Poppy Bloom incident response.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The coordination with local partnering agencies along with CHP will ensure the safety of the staff, residents, and area visitors.
