Re: The Unlawful Appointment of Pablo Bryant to the Temecula Elsinore Anza Murrieta Resource Conversation District ("TEAM RCD")Board

Dear Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside:

Our office has been retained to represent Government Watchdogs in this matter. Government Watchdogs is an unincorporated association that focuses on government integrity and holding the government accountable to its people. Please direct all correspondence concerning this matter to the undersigned.

It has come to our attention that Pablo Bryant's appointment as a board member to TEAM RCD by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ("Board of Supervisors") was unlawful and is legally actionable. Additionally, the conduct of the Board of Supervisors and of Supervisor Chuck Washington were violations of procedural due process under the California Constitution. Considering the strength of the legal arguments outlined below, the Board of Supervisors should immediately take all necessary steps to rescind the appointment of Pablo Bryant as a board member of TEAM RCD. If the Board of Supervisors fail to take all the necessary steps to rescind Mr. Bryant's appointment, our Client will have no other choice but to pursue all legal and equitable remedies available to it to ensure citizens of the County of Riverside are not subject to the arbitrary and undemocratic whims of the Board of Supervisors.

It is within the Board of Supervisors' power to remedy the unlawful appointment of Mr. Bryant to TEAM RCD and doing so is not just the legally correct thing to do, it is also the right thing to do. The citizens of the County of Riverside have delegated power to the Board of Supervisors by electing them to govern fairly and justly. Here, given the questionable and illegal circumstances of Mr. Bryant's appointment, justice and fairness can only be achieved through removing him from his position as a board member of TEAM RCD.

Before discussing the legal arguments favoring our Client's position in this matter, a brief outline of the facts and circumstances are due. This factual discussion will be organized in two

sections. The first section will highlight the relevant regulations governing the procedure for appointing board members to TEAM RCD that the Board of Supervisors *must* follow when making appointments. The second section will detail the specific facts concerning Mr. Bryant's appointment as a board member of TEAM RCD which show his appointment is illegal.

Procedural Rules the Board is Obligated to Follow

First, there is a well-defined process for TEAM RCD board member appointments by the Board of Supervisors. According to Riverside County Ordinance No. 662, the Board of Supervisors appoints directors onto TEAM RCD from candidates who filed an application with the Registrar of Voters ("ROV"). In the case at hand, the Board of Supervisors has the authority to appoint a director to TEAM RCD under Public Resources Code Sections 9314(b)(1) and 9314(c), and Riverside County Ordinance No.662 Sections 1 and 2(b). Section 9314(b)(1) states, "the board of supervisors shall appoint directors from those candidates who have filed an application with the board of supervisors, as prescribed by the board of supervisors. If the directors are to be appointed, a notice of election shall not be published, but a notice of vacancy shall be posted pursuant to section 54974 of the Government Code" Section 9314(c) states that "in selecting directors pursuant to subdivision (b), the board of supervisors shall endeavor to achieve balanced representation on the board of directors." Ordinance No. 662 Section 1 states, "[i]n accordance with Section 9314 of Public Resources Code, the application for appointment as director of a Resource Conservation District shall be the Declaration of Candidacy form prescribed in Elections Code Section 10511, as provided by the Registrar of Voters. Completed applications are to be filed with the Registrar of Voters by the applicable filing deadline date." Ordinance No. 662 Section 2(b) states, "The application required to be filed by candidates shall be the Declaration of Candidacy form prescribed in Elections Code paragraph 23512.2, as provided by the Registrar of Voters. Completed applications are to be filed with the Registrar of Voters by the applicable filing deadline date." (Emphasis Added.)

Facts of Mr. Bryant's Illegal Appointment

There are two issues regarding Mr. Bryant's appointment. First is Mr. Bryant's initial application for a vacancy on TEAM RCD that was submitted on **September 6, 2022, at 12:45 p.m.** (the "First Application"). On this application, Mr. Bryant stated he was the designated agent of Raymond Stann, who, at the time, owned property within the district. The property listed on the application was 30980 Calle Fuente, Temecula, CA 92591 ("Calle Fuente Property"). The Calle Fuente Property was listed for sale since June 24, 2022, and a real estate purchase agreement was entered into on July 7, 2022. Notably, on August 6, 2022, Mr. Stann wrote a letter to support Mr. Bryant's application. Mr. Stann noted he was a resident of Riverside County and owned the Calle Fuente Property. Two months after entering into the purchase agreement for the Calle Fuente Property, on **September 6, 2022, at 2:40 p.m.**, the Property was sold, and the new owners recorded the Calle Fuente Property deed with the County of Riverside. This means that Mr. Bryant was no longer serving as a valid proxy for Raymond Stann as required for his First Application. Attached as **Exhibit "A"** is Mr. Bryant's First Application and the deed for the Calle Fuente Property.

Further, Mr. Bryant is not a citizen of Riverside County, and he otherwise did not (and still does not) have ownership interests in any real property in Riverside County. This being the case, his eligibility for appointment to the TEAM RCD board was reliant on his representing Raymond Stann as a proxy through Mr. Stann's ownership of the Calle Fuente Property. Inexplicably, there was no verification by the ROV concerning Mr. Bryant's eligibility to serve on the TEAM RCD board. Without any verification of his proxy status taking place, and without actually serving as a legitimate proxy for Mr. Stann after Mr. Stann sold his property, Mr. Bryant has served on the board of TEAM RCD since September 7, 2022, illegally.

Second, there is an issue as to the vacancy on TEAM RCD which opened up on November 7, 2022. On November 7, 2022, the ROV issued and posted a Notice of Vacancy for directors of TEAM RCD whose term was ending on November 22, 2022. The Notice of Vacancy opened the application filing date as of November 7, 2022, and provided a closure date of November 22, 2022. Importantly, the ROV expressly stated in the ROV calendar that applications were to be filed with the ROV no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 9, 2022. Attached as Exhibit "B" is ROV's calendar.

At some point after the deadline, Supervisor Chuck Washington and other Riverside County officials realized that there was a problem with Mr. Bryant's First Application. Upon this realization, the Board of Supervisors overrode the expressly stated ROV deadline so that Mr. Bryant could submit a new application on January 11, 2023 (the "Second Application"). Mr. Bryant's Second Application stated he was the designated agent of Mr. Stann for a different property in the district. This new property was located at 43001 Calle Camellia, Temecula, CA 92592 and was purchased by Mr. Stann on September 7, 2022. Supervisor Washington characterized Mr. Bryant's invalid (and potentially fraudulent) First Application as a "small paperwork issue." Following the submission of the Second Application on January 11, 2023, Supervisor Washington called for Mr. Bryant's re-appointment to TEAM RCD on January 24, 2023. Attached as Exhibit "C" is Mr. Bryant's Second Application. Note, the submission date for the Second Application upon which Mr. Bryant's reappointment is based, was submitted more than a month after the December 9, 2022, deadline. Ultimately, the Board of Supervisors approved the Second Application despite the facts it was over a month late, and despite the fact that there were three other valid applications which were all submitted within the appropriate time frame. Additionally, Supervisor Washington unlawfully used questionnaires seeking information from the other applicants which went beyond the strict qualifications set by the Public Resources Code. Attached as Exhibit "D" are the applications of Pablo Bryant, Jeff McClenahan, and Andy Domenigoni that were given the supplemental questionnaire and not Randy Feeney, Rose Corona, and Sebastian Valente. Attached as Exhibit "E" are the applications of Randy Feeney, Rose Corona, and Sebastian Valente that were not given the supplemental questionnaires.

To briefly summarize the facts, Mr. Bryant's First application is invalid because he did not have a legitimate proxy for the Calle Fuente Property. This much is acknowledged by the Board of Supervisors' conduct requiring Mr. Bryant to submit a second application due to a "small paperwork issue." This is not to mention the absurd characterization of a substantive eligibility requirement for service on the board as "minor." Similarly, Mr. Bryant's Second Application is also invalid because, while he did submit a second application with a valid basis for proxy representation, the Second Application was submitted *more than a month after the required deadline*. Despite the invalidity of both applications, the Board of Supervisors approved and appointed Mr. Bryant based on the Second Application on January 24, 2023.

The Board of Supervisors' Violation of Statutory Deadlines

Given both applications (and the appointments based on them) are invalid, our Client is prepared to file suit for the Board of Supervisors' violations of established law. There is ample authority supporting strict compliance with election filings that have statutory deadlines using language such as "not less" than or "not later" than a given deadline. (Steele v. Bartlett (1941) 18 Cal.2d 573, 574; Griffin v. Dingley (1896) 114 Cal. 481, 482.) Here, the language of Riverside County Ordinance No. 662, section 1, which states: "Completed applications are to be filed with the Registrar of Voters by the applicable filing deadline date." (emphasis added). Additionally, the ROV calendar concerning the December 9, 2022 deadline called for submission of applications "no later than" 5:00 PM on December 9, 2022 (emphasis added). Given the Board of Supervisors accepted Mr. Bryant's second application on January 11, 2023, the Board of Supervisors is in clear

violation of California case law concerning filing deadlines for elections and appointments to local government bodies.

Further, given Mr. Bryant currently sits on the board of TEAM RCD despite having never submitted a valid application for the position, the Board of Supervisors is in clear violation of its duties to the citizens of the County of Riverside. Such violations include but are not limited to an abuse of power under County of Riverside California, *Board of Supervisors Policy*, Policy Number C-35; violations of County of Riverside, Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2.78 Code of Ethics and Conduct; and violations of California Government Code, Title 9. Political Reform, sections 81000 *et seq*.

The Board of Supervisors' Due Process Violations

Further, there are two instances of conduct which must be discussed further because both run afoul of the California Constitution. Under the California Constitution, "[a] person may not be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law or denied equal protection of the laws" (Cal. Const., art. I, § 7.) While this provision parallels the language of its United States Constitution ("U.S. Constitution") counterpart, in practice, the California Constitution provides a broader swath of protection than the U.S. constitution. (See Ryan v. California Interscholastic Federation-San Diego Section (2001) 94 Cal.App.4th 1048 [contrasting the federal protections for due process with California's due process protections].) The Ryan court noted, California's due process protections "[f]ocused [] on an individual's due process liberty interest to be free from arbitrary adjudicative procedures... procedural due process under the California Constitution is 'much more inclusive' and protects a broader range of interests than under the federal Constitution. (Ibid.) In California, a plaintiff asserting a due process violation will only need to show, "a statutorily conferred benefit or interest of which he or she has been deprived." (Id. at 1071.) To establish if such a statutorily conferred benefit has been deprived under the California Constitution, court will balance and consider the following factors:

(1) [T]he private interest that will be affected by the official action[;] (2) the risk of an erroneous deprivation of such interest through the procedures used, and the probable value, if any, of additional or substitute procedural safeguards[;] (3) the dignitary interest in informing individuals of the nature, grounds and consequences of the action and in enabling them to present their side of the story before a responsible governmental official[;] and, (4) the governmental interest, including the function involved and the fiscal and administrative burdens that the additional or substitute procedural requirement would entail.

Here, the Board of Supervisors violated the due process clause by considering unqualified candidates for the TEAM RCD position absent any statutory authority to justify consideration of a late applicant. Under the Elections Code paragraph 23512.2, only the timely applications had a right to be considered. The unprecedented consideration of Mr. Bryant's late application gives rise to a violation of due process as related to each timely applicant who had their applications arbitrarily subverted to Mr. Bryant's.

Additionally, the Board of Supervisors further violated due process when it unilaterally incorporated a questionnaire as part of the basis of its decision in considering applicants. As noted in the discussion above, there are strict qualifications for serving in the TEAM RCD position dictated by the Public Resources Code; and none of the qualifications mentioned include the parameters emphasized by the arbitrary questionnaire. By using the questionnaire as a pretext for disqualifying the timely—and otherwise valid—applications, the Board of Supervisors clearly violated the interest the applicants had in competing for the TEAM RCD position with only valid applications. The Board of Supervisor's ad hoc creation of new criteria via the questionnaire and

of a new filing deadline by accepting Mr. Bryant's application more than a month after the deadline clearly violates the interest the candidates have in participating in a selection process which is compliant with clearly defined statutory parameters. Further, by using *ad hoc* and random procedures to select TEAM RCD members, the Board of Supervisors created a high risk that future selections will also be made with similar *ad hoc* and arbitrary criteria in the selection process in the future. At no point were the interested candidates given an opportunity to challenge the change in rules and procedures governing the selection of the TEAM RCD members. Our Client is not asking the Board of Supervisors to overhaul the process of selecting TEAM RCD members, nor is it asking the County of Riverside to implement new or more burdensome rules and regulations. Simply, our Client is merely asking the Board of Supervisors to comply with the existing laws and rules governing this process.

In conclusion, we demand that the Board of Supervisors rescind Mr. Bryant's appointment immediately. Any failure to take the appropriate steps to rescind Mr. Bryant's appointment will be understood to be a rejection of this demand. In the event Mr. Bryant is not immediately removed, our Client has given us approval to pursue all legal and equitable remedies available to protect the Citizens of Riverside County from the illegal conduct of the Board of Supervisors in approving Mr. Bryant's appointment to the board of TEAM RCD. You may request to be heard on a published agenda item. Requests to be heard must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board before the scheduled meeting time.

Requests to Address Board on items that are "NOT" on the Agenda/Public Comment:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these rules, a member of the public shall have the right to address the Board during the mid-morning "Oral Communications" segment of the published agenda. Said purpose for address must pertain to issues which are under the direct jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors. YOUR TIME WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES. Donated time is not permitted during Public Comment.

Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, insuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please ensure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo.

Individual Speaker Limits:

Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes. Please step up to the podium when the Chairman calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin to flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. The Chairman adheres to a strict three (3) minutes per speaker. Note: If you intend to give your time to a "Group/Organized Presentation", please state so clearly at the very bottom of the reverse side of this form.

Group/Organized Presentations:

Group/organized presentations with more than one (1) speaker will be limited to nine (9) minutes at the Chairman's discretion. The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the bottom of the form.

Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chairman:

The Chairman will determine what order the speakers will address the Board, and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles in order to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the general public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chairman, may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.
