BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Riverside County Youth Commission will be hosting their 25th Annual Youth Summit. An event that provides an opportunity for youth to discuss topics that are important to them and how we can help meet their needs. Funding will include needed transportation to 300 students attending the event. Fifteen community resource exhibitors will be in attendance to provide professional and resourceful information.
2. Perris Valley Filipino-American Association, Inc., funding will support the cultural competency program that provides assistance to the Asian American communities within the Fifth District. PVFAA donation will also be used for community action programs and community events throughout the year.
3. Smiles for Seniors Foundation will provide emergency assistance and safety services to hundreds of low-income seniors over the age of 65 to include food, housing, utility payments, minor home and auto repairs as well as prescriptions and medical equipment.
4. March Field Air Museum funding will be used for annual community events to support the museum's mission to educate the public by helping to promote an understanding of humanity's reach for the skies and connecting this still-unfolding story to March Field and its pivotal role in the development of flight.
