Bill was born in Joplin, Missouri on October 5, 1937. After serving in the U.S. Air Force and spending time in Korea, Bill was stationed at March Air Force Base in California. Following his honorable discharge in 1964, he chose to settle in the Inland Empire.

Bill first worked as a fireman for the City of Riverside Fire Department and then in the drapery business. Soon After, Jones got into the steel fabrication and placement business employing 40 people and providing steel rebar to developers of homes across California. From 1970 to 2003, Bill owned and operated Enterprise Steel.

Alongside his business, Bill was involved in several organizations, including the Riverside Elks Lodge and the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 10267, Jurupa, where he personally funded the organization's beginning and provided housing and jobs to veterans in the Jurupa communities. Bill was honored for his service by being inducted into the VFW Hall of Fame.

Jones was married to Noralee for over two decades and later married Sue Clark and Andrea. He had four sons named Ralph, Lee, Boyd, and Brian, who he raised in his "yard" and taught his business skills to. Jones loved to travel, especially on cruises, but he also attended Rubidoux High School basketball games to cheer on his son, Brian.


