Approval of the Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise for Bid for the Construction of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard Resurfacing Project, in the Community of University City; CEQA Exempt, District 1. [\$625,115 Total Cost - Local Funds 100%] (Clerk to Advertise)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Sycamore Canyon Boulevard Resurfacing Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Sycamore Canyon Boulevard Resurfacing Project, in the Community of University City;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 24, 2023 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface an approximate 0.63-mile segment of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard in the community of University City of Riverside County. The limits on Sycamore Canyon Boulevard are from Central Avenue to 700-foot southeast of College Boulevard.

Sycamore Canyon Boulevard varies between a four-lane and two-lane facility with a road width of 34 to 75 feet and is currently classified as a secondary arterial road in the circulation element of the County of Riverside General Plan.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the proposed resurfacing project will include two treatment types. The first treatment consists of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material on an approximately 0.27-mile segment of roadway and placing back Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA) over Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement. The second treatment will require grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement on an approximately 0.36-mile segment of roadway followed by overlaying back with RHMA.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of sidewalk, curb and gutter, curb ramp, safety features include placing of thermoplastic traffic striping with enhanced wet night visibility, reflective pavement markers, thermoplastic pavement markings, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

The adjustment of the facilities owned by City of Riverside (City), are also included in the bid package as an alternative bid schedule. If City approves the award of their alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the City through reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Sycamore Canyon Boulevard resurfacing does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt and rubberized hot mix asphalt for the approximate 0.63-mile segment of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard in the Community of University City to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2023. Construction will be performed at night in order to reduce impact to traffic and reduce delays. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$625,115. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: I

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department (CRTD) proposes to resurface approximately 3,200 feet (0.60 mile) of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard (Blvd). Sycamore Canyon Blvd is a secondary arterial road that travels in the north-south direction between Central Ave to south of College Blvd. Sycamore Canyon Blvd currently varies between a four lane and two-lane facility with a road width of 34-75 feet.

The proposed project will include but is not limited to the following:

- One weekend road closure
- Seal cracks and apply tack coat prior to overlaying with rubberized hot-mix asphalt and/or hot mix asphalt
- Reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter, and sidewalk
- Adjust utility manholes
- Installation of detector loops
- Placement of traffic striping, retroreflective pavement markers, and thermoplastic pavement markings
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Any other work as may be required

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

This proposed project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within cell criteria areas. This project is within a cell criteria area and is a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918 (MBTA) and California Fish and Game Codes Section 3503, 3503.5, 3513, and 3800.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project will resurface approximately 3,200 feet (0.60 mile) of Sycamore Canyon Blvd between Central Ave and College Blvd. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities (e.g., signage) with negligible or no expansion of use.

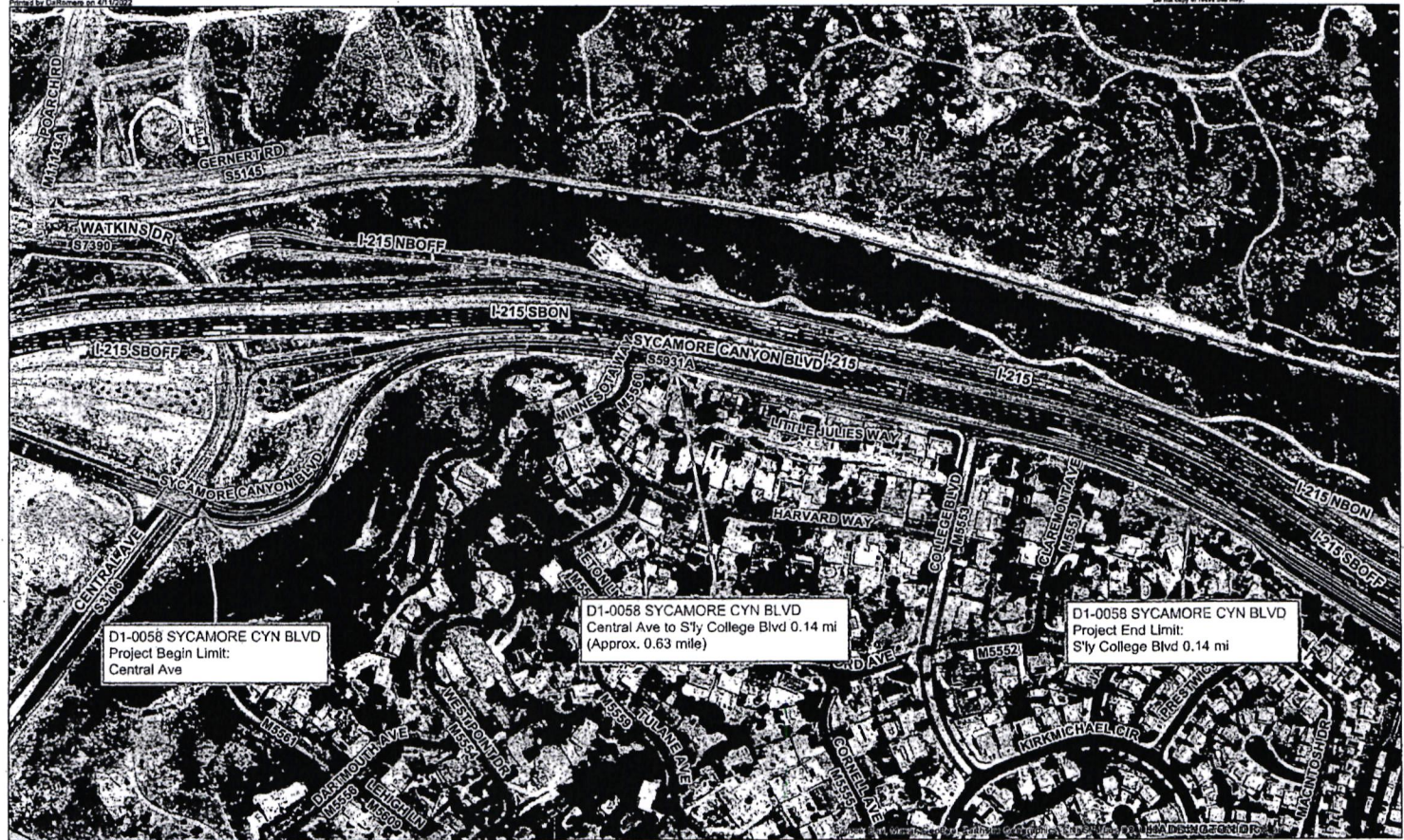

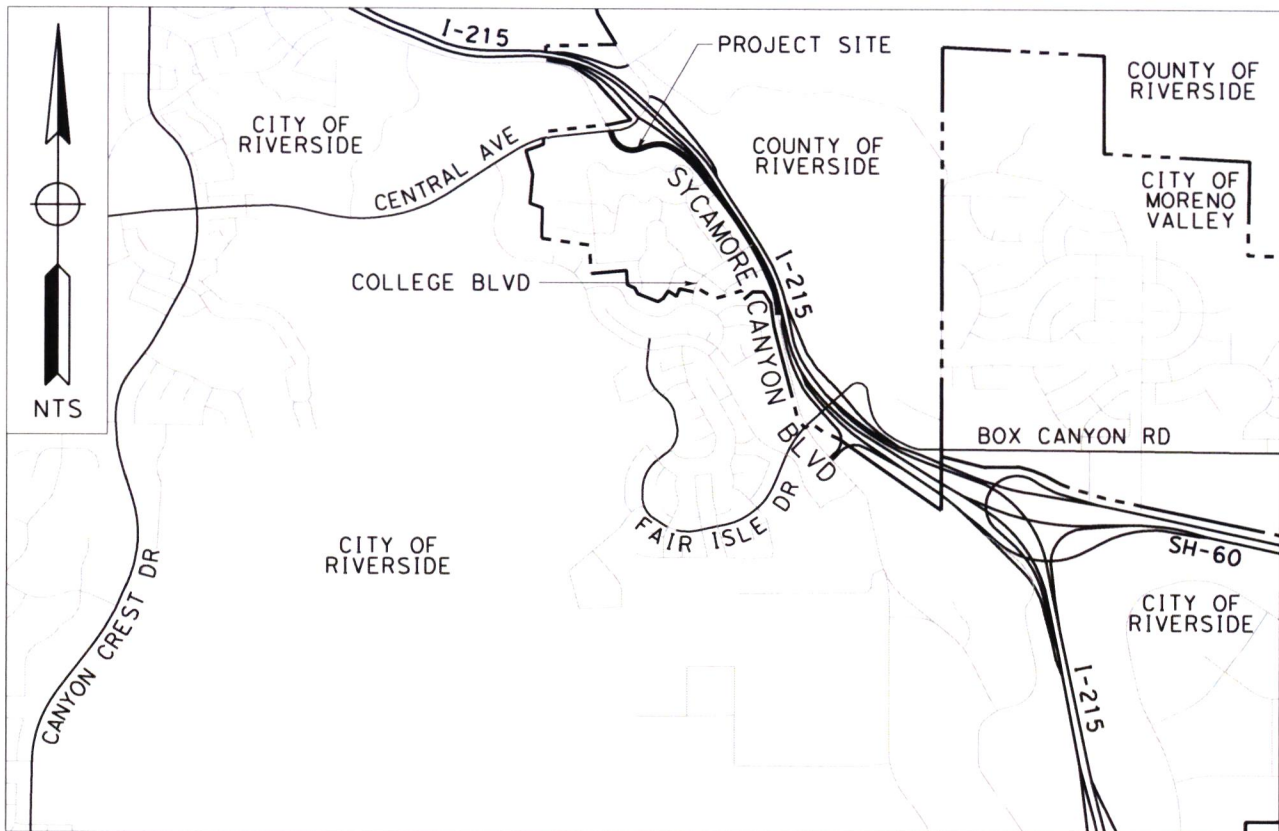
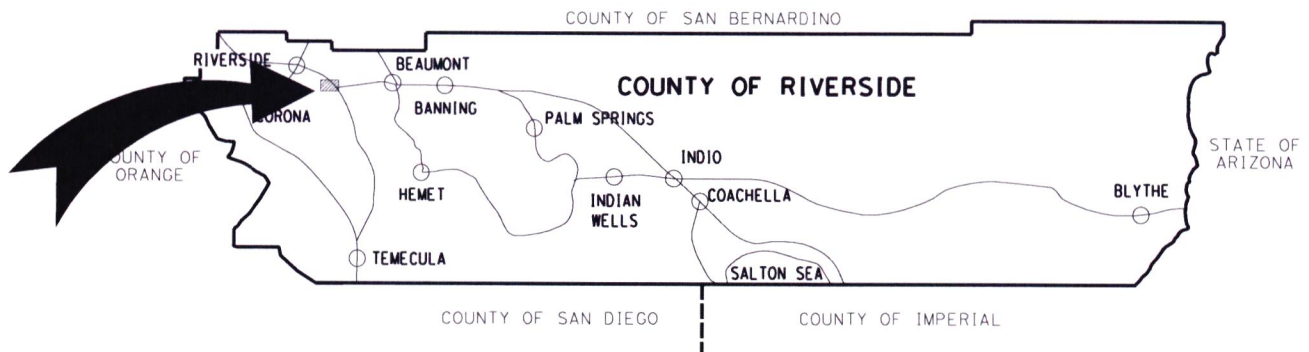
