BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Voices for Children – The funds will be used to support children, who are assigned a volunteer Court Appointed Special Advocate. These volunteers advocate for children from birth to 21 years of age throughout the Third District.
2. Western Science Center – The funding will be used for the ‘Science Exploration Experience’ (SEE). The SEE program encompasses the Center’s educational offerings at the museum with exhibits, field trips, summer day camps and other science programs.
3. Boys and Girls Club of Menifee Valley – Funds will be used for operational support, as well as financial assistance for youth members to participate in enrichment programs like sports, dance, etc. The clubhouses serve over 1,000 children from the ages of three to eighteen years old.
4. Reaching New Heights Foundation – Funding will go to the annual The Ruck Challenge, a 10k run, to raise funds and awareness for veterans, who are suffering from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and traumatic brain injury (TBI). The veterans will receive structured rehabilitation programs with community and law enforcement oversight.
5. Healthy Valley Foundation – The funds will be utilized for a fundraiser to support a rehabilitation project for a local outdoor activity space located at Simpson Park in East Hemet, that was badly damaged during the Fairview fire.
