BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, Inc. funding will be utilized to assist the housing programs, services and projects such as the 2023 Fair Housing Conference. The conference will bring together community non-profits, government officials, lenders, builders, policy makers and housing providers to address the issues of the future of housing in the Inland Empire.
2. H.E.L.P. Inc. donation will provide support towards low-income individuals and families to their food pantry as well as financial assistance for utilities, rent, transportation and shelter.
3. Butterfield Language Academy Ballet Folklorico Club will utilize funding to purchase authentic culture costumes for students such as skirts, hats, and blouses for the Cinco de Mayo folk-dance performance.
