

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Riverside County Transportation Department is responsible for the planning, design, funding, building, operation, and maintenance of approximately 2,266 miles of roads and 116 bridges within unincorporated Riverside County. These roads and bridges are inspected regularly and the inspection reports are a tool used to help the department prioritize and fund project improvements. In 2020, the average pavement condition in unincorporated Riverside County was given a C- rating, by the American Society of Civil Engineers, with the primary source of funding for pavement repair being gas tax.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) was passed to improve the State's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly the roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing and reconstruction. The passing of SB 1 included the creation of the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Program and the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), which has provided a much-needed infusion of funds for transportation improvements. Without SB 1 these needed road repair projects would have been shelved until funding became available. The SB 1/RMRA fund is restricted to a "Fix-It-First" approach and requires local agencies to focus on roadway rehabilitation and maintenance to improve the condition of existing infrastructure across the State. These funds are restricted and can only be used for roadway and bridge maintenance and rehabilitation, safety improvements, grade separations, and traffic control devices.

SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions to ensure that the residents of unincorporated Riverside County are informed of local projects proposed to be funded with SB 1 funds. The California Transportation Commission (CTC) Guidelines requires that in order to receive SB 1/RMRA funding, counties must provide evidence to the CTC by July 1, 2023, that the County has adopted a list of projects planned to be funded in FY 2023/2024 with SB 1/RMRA funds. The list must include a description and location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's start and completion, as well as the estimated useful life of the improvement. See Attachment A for the list of proposed projects to be funded with SB 1/RMRA funding in FY 2023/2024.

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The Transportation Department currently has approximately \$519 million in projects either under construction or close to starting construction across the County. The projects in progress range in scope from simple preventative maintenance projects to complex interchange reconstruction and grade separation projects and are funded from a variety of sources including local, State, and Federal funds. A complete listing of these projects can be found in the Transportation Improvement Program that was approved by the Board on October 18, 2022, item 3.42.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Because of the SB 1/RMRA funding, it is expected that the County will be able to improve the pavement condition of the County maintained roads that are in need of resurfacing or reconstruction.

The proposed roadway improvements will be constructed in a manner to minimize disruption to the public and advance notice will be provided before beginning work.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The FY 2023/2024 SB 1/RMRA allocations to the County of Riverside are estimated to be over \$45 million. The FY 2023/2024 SB 1 "unrestricted" allocations to the County of Riverside is estimated to be over \$18 million. A portion of this funding will be used for Operational needs of the department such as routine maintenance activities, salaries and benefits, vehicles, and insurance.

No General funds will be used for these projects.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE**

**APPROVING A LIST OF PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED IN FY 2023/24 BY SB1:**

**THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of unincorporated County of Riverside are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside must approve a list of projects which shall include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, will receive an estimated \$45,123,569 of RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2023/24 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the seventh year in which the County of Riverside is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County of Riverside to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list shown on Attachment A to ensure revenues are being used on

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1 the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for  
2 transportation investment; and

3 WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County of Riverside maintain  
4 and rehabilitate the Attachment A listed streets/roads, improve road safety and add active  
5 transportation infrastructure throughout the County in Fiscal Year 2023/24 and hundreds of  
6 similar projects into the future; and

7 WHEREAS, without revenue from SB 1, the resurfacing/reconstruction of the  
8 roads listed on Attachment A would have been delayed for the foreseeable future; and

9 WHEREAS, cities and counties own and operate more than 81 percent of  
10 streets and roads in California, and the public is dependent upon a safe, reliable local  
11 transportation network.

12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by  
13 the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session  
14 assembled on May 23rd, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. or soon thereafter, in the meeting room located  
15 on the first floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside,  
16 California, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the list of projects planned to  
17 be funded in FY 2023/24 in part or solely with SB 1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation  
18 Account revenues, as shown on Attachment A.
