1. Find that the Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp Accessibility Project for Fiscal Year 2023/24 is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp Accessibility Project for Fiscal Year 2023/24 at various locations in the 4th and 5th Districts;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 28, 2023, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days of Board approval.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The slurry seal treatment is provided as a preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The slurry seal treatment seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and helps preserve the underlying pavement structure. This project includes various roads located within the communities of Cherry Valley, Thousand Palms, Lake Tamarisk, and the unincorporated areas near the City of Cathedral City and City of Beaumont. The specific roads are listed in "Attachment 1".

The slurry seal project proposes slurry seal, micro-surfacing, and chip seal treatments based on the existing pavement conditions. The slurry seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregates, water and other additives placed over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes road cleaning, crack repair, crack sealing, asphalt concrete repairs, application of seal coat treatment, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times at specified intervals after the slurry has been applied.

The micro-surfacing treatment is similar to the slurry seal except it uses polymer modified and fast setting asphalt emulsion allowing thicker layers to be placed. The thick layer application allows to fill in ruts commonly found on roadways with light to moderate truck traffic.

The chip seal treatment consists of an application of asphalt emulsion and then followed by a layer of chip or small crushed rock (screenings). The treatment provides a skid resistant wearing surface and seals minor cracks, and it is generally used for low volume rural roads.

This project also proposes to reconstruct or upgrade five (5) existing concrete curb ramps at various locations within the 5th District, as part of the Transportation Department goal to provide safe and usable pedestrian facilities for all pedestrians and to comply with the Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. As part of the ADA requirement, curb ramps must be upgraded when adjoining roads are altered through resurfacing or placement of a thick layer of seal coat. The specific curb ramp locations are listed in "Attachment 2."

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

The proposed curb ramp accessibility work will consist of modifying or removing existing concrete curb ramps and placing back ADA compliant concrete curb ramps. Certain curb ramps will be upgraded by installing yellow detectable warning devices (series of small bumps or truncated domes) and making repairs to street landing slopes to meet ADA compliance. Detectable warning devices are used to alert pedestrians who are blind or visually impaired that there is vehicle traffic nearby.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule:	Slurry Seal and associated work
Alternative Bid Schedule 1:	Curb Ramps and associated work
Alternative Bid Schedule 2:	Repair of Existing Asphalt Concrete Surfaces
Alternative Bid Schedule 3:	Slurry Seal and associated work, City of Cathedral City
Alternative Bid Schedule 4:	Slurry Seal and associated work, City of Beaumont

If the low bid is approved and concurred to by the City of Cathedral City and Beaumont for their respective alternative bid schedule of work, then reimbursement agreements between the Cities and the County will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Project Numbers: D4-0009, D4-0010 (Slurry Seal District 4 and 5)
D4-0015 (Curb Ramps District 5)

Environmental Findings

The proposed projects are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the slurry seal treatment and the reconstruction or modification of curb ramps do not create additional traffic lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadways and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The Slurry Seal treatment will extend the life of the pavement thereby reducing the need for more extensive types of resurfacing that can be up to ten times more costly.

The reconstruction of curb ramps is expected to improve the access and safety of disabled persons using the pedestrian facilities along the roadways. In addition, bringing the curb ramps up to current accessibility standards contributes toward fulfilling the County Transportation Department's goals as stated in its ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan as required by Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,885,280 and construction is anticipated to be completed in FY 2023/2024. The Slurry Seal and Curb Ramp work will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1, Measure A/ Western, Measure A/ Coachella Valley, City of Cathedral City, and City of Beaumont funds.

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: 4th & 5th

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to provide slurry seal treatment to existing pavement surfaces on various roads located in unincorporated locations throughout Districts 4 and 5 of Riverside County.

Slurry seal treatments consist of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small, crushed rock), water, and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. The treatments are provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. Slurry seal treatments seal cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface, provide a new black pavement surface color, and help preserve the underlying pavement structure.

The Chip seal treatment adds a layer of "chips" or small crushed rock, over the slurry seal as a "wearing course" in areas of higher vehicles traffic. Micro-surfacing is similar to slurry seal. It consists of the application of a mixture of water, asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small, crushed rock), and chemical additives to an existing asphalt concrete pavement surface. Micro-surfacing contains chemical additives which allow it to break without relying on the sun or heat for evaporation to occur.

The work also involves replacing non-compliant curb ramps, removing, and replacing thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings/paint traffic stripes and other work as may be required.

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ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The proposed project does not require additional right of way nor temporary construction easements. The project will extend the life of the pavement of the treated roads, which is a benefit to the traveling public. The project consists of maintenance and repair of an existing public road. There is no expansion of use of the road as a result of the project.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plans (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside/inside of cell criteria area/conservation areas. This project is considered to be an operation and maintenance; therefore, it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP).

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to provide slurry seal treatment to existing pavement surfaces on various roads and replace non-compliant curb ramps, remove and replace thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings/paint traffic stripes located in unincorporated locations throughout Districts 4 and 5 of Riverside County. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

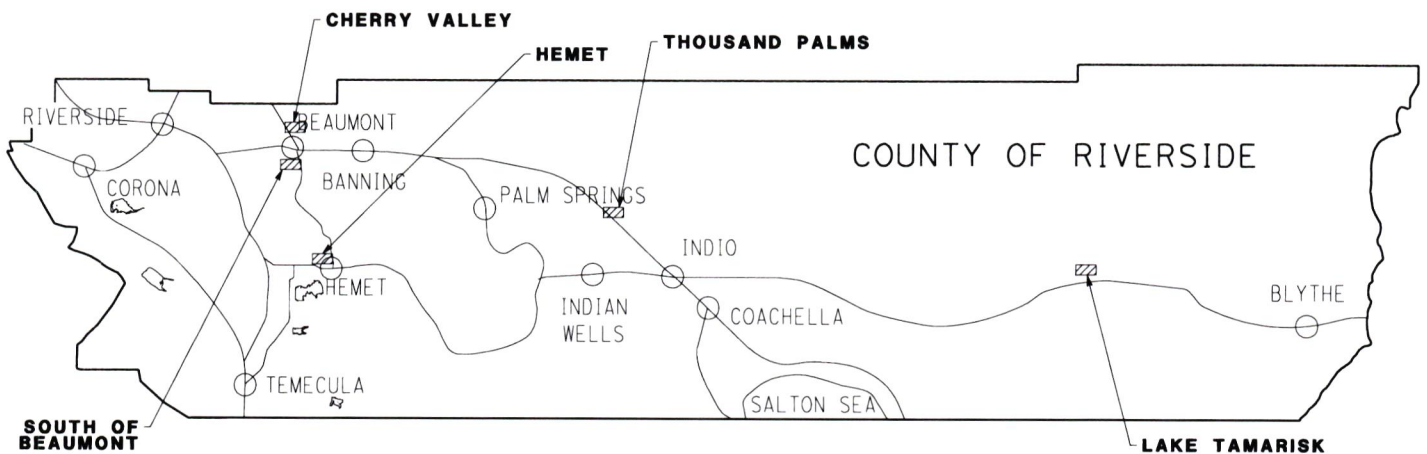
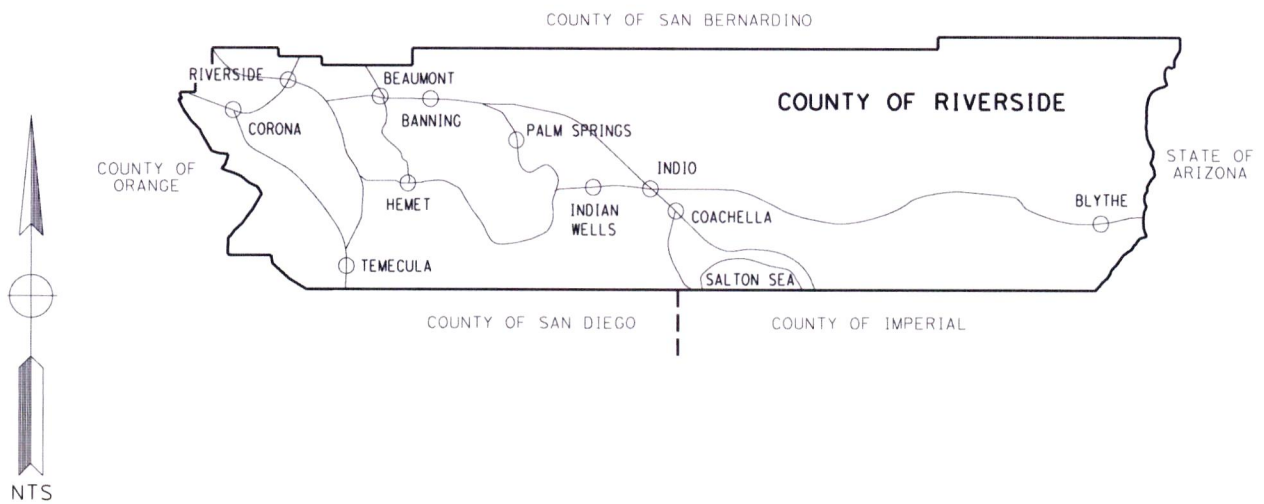
VICINITY MAP
