**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The District Attorney's Office is requesting the authorization to submit for Grant funding from the Cal OES Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims of Crime Program. The purpose of the Program is to implement new and unique methods to provide direct support services for victims/survivors of crime who are part of a marginalized population.

Approximately \$8,967,500 is available for calendar year 2024, with Riverside County potentially being awarded up to \$224,000 with a required 20% in-kind match on the part of the County. The grant award performance period is 12 months, beginning January 1, 2024, and ending December 31, 2024.

The District Attorney's Office did not anticipate funding for this program within their projected revenue budget for FY23/24; as a result, a budget modification will be necessary if the funding is awarded. The awarded revenue impacts for FY24/25 will be included in the department's budget submittal when it is prepared early next year.

Award documents will be submitted to the Board for approval when the grant funds are distributed, and the financial data table will be revised accordingly.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Grant Subawards Certification of Assurance of Compliance Cal OES Form 2-104 as to form.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

This funding source for such a critical program provides ample return on the County's 20% matching funds. The matching fund requirement for this program consists of a portion of the District Attorney's existing county budget and does not require any additional county funding to be allocated.
