C.E.O. RECOMMENDATION: Approve

California Environmental Quality Act and Environmental Document Filling Fees

These statutory pass-through fees pertain to the California Environmental Quality Act and Environmental Document Filing and are adjusted annually by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife effective January 1st of each year in accordance with Fish and Game Code Sections 711.4 and 713 and are uniform throughout the State of California.

To be more efficient, the Assessor, County Clerk and Recorder (ACR) is requesting to change Ordinance No. 729 ("Ordinance") to refer to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife's publication of these pass-through fees. Since these fees are imposed by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the ACR would like to streamline the process by removing the specific dollar amount on the Ordinance. This change would result in a public benefit by saving the administrative costs of annually reapproving pass-through fees in a County public hearing that have already been determined by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. The dollar amount will be correctly reflected on the Fee Schedule as a course of normal business.

For reference, the fees effective 1/1/2023 are as follows:

Copy and Certification of Vital Records Fees

In 2021, the State Assembly passed Assembly Bill 128, which authorized an increase to the vital fees for certified copies of birth, death, and public marriage licenses referenced in Health and Safety Code Sections 100425, 103525.5, 103625, 103625(b)(2), and 103650. The fee is established by the California Department of Public Health and notice of these ministerial fees are distributed through an all-county letter. The State required the increase effective January 1, 2022.

To be more efficient, the ACR is requesting to change the Ordinance to refer to the California Department of Public Health's determination of these fees. This change would result in a public benefit by saving the administrative costs of periodically reapproving fees in a County public hearing that have already been determined by the California Department of Public Health. The dollar amount will be correctly reflected on the Fee Schedule as a course of normal business.

Restrictive Covenants Modification Program Fee

With the passing of AB 1466 and the subsequent creation of Government Code section 27388.2, the County recorder may impose a \$2.00 fee on each real estate instrument, paper, or notice. The funds generated by this fee shall be used only by the County recorder collecting the fee for the purpose of implementing a restrictive covenants program. Creation of a subfund is necessary to track applicable revenue and expenditures. Pursuant to Government Code section 27388.2(c), the County recorder shall not charge this fee after December 31, 2027, unless it has received reauthorization by the Board of Supervisors. The County recorder shall not seek reauthorization of the fee by the Board before June 1, 2027, or after December 31, 2027. Any reauthorization period shall not exceed five (5) years.

The Restricted Covenant Modification (RCM) Program seeks to hasten the removal of the offensive covenants in three (3) ways:

- 1. The bill requires all county recorders throughout the state to establish an RCM program to identify and redact unlawfully restrictive covenants and make regular reports on its progress to the Legislature.
- 2. The bill allows any person, not just an owner, to file an RCM with the county recorder's office if they have knowledge of the unlawful restriction.
- 3. The bill enables a person with an ownership interest to record an RCM by waiving fees and requires title companies, realtors, and specified others who know of such restriction to notify an owner or prospective owner of the existence of the restriction, and to inform them of their right to use the RCM process.

County recorders are required to perform the duties assigned under this measure, including tracking, and maintaining a record of homes with unlawfully restrictive covenants once they have been identified, even if the Board of Supervisors does not authorize the fee.

A pro forma version of the proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 729 has been attached as Exhibit A. The Office of County Counsel has approved the Ordinance amendments as to form. The Board of Supervisors introduced the Ordinance amendment in regular session on May 23, 2023 (Item 3.55).

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Upon Board approval of the proposed amendments to the Ordinance, the updates will be reflected on the ACR's fee schedule and made available to the public.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows:

Section 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE.

- A. PURPOSE. The purpose of this section is to establish fees in reasonable amounts to cover the costs of rendering certain enumerated services and supplies furnished by the Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder's Office.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY. Should any fee herein established be held to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of all remaining fee provisions.

<u>Section 3. LISTING NOT COMPREHENSIVE</u>. This Ordinance is not intended to contain all fees that are or may be charged by the Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder for services and supplies and to the extent that other fees are customarily charged or are established elsewhere and are not listed below, all such fees, charges, and rates shall remain in full force and effect.

- 1. Introduce and waive further reading of proposed Ordinance No. 729.10, an ordinance of the County of Riverside amending Ordinance No. 729 establishing fees, charges, and rates for Assessor, County Clerk and Recorder Services;
- 2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to set a public hearing for the proposed ordinance to be heard on June 13, 2023;
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to provide notice of the public hearing in accordance with Section 54986 of the Government Code; and
- 4. Upon adoption, direct the Auditor-Controller to establish a subfund for the Restrictive Covenant Modification Program to account for all related revenue and expenditures.

California Environmental Quality Act and Environmental Document Filling Fees

These statutory pass-through fees pertain to the California Environmental Quality Act and Environmental Document Filing and are adjusted annually by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife effective January 1st of each year in accordance with Fish and Game Code Sections 711.4 and 713 and are uniform throughout the State of California.

To be more efficient, the Assessor, County Clerk and Recorder (ACR) is requesting to change Ordinance No. 729 ("Ordinance") to refer to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife's publication of these pass-through fees. Since these fees are imposed by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the ACR would like to streamline the process by removing the specific dollar amount on the Ordinance. This change would result in a public benefit by saving the administrative costs of annually reapproving pass-through fees in a County public hearing that have already been determined by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. The dollar amount will be correctly reflected on the Fee Schedule as a course of normal business.

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Copy and Certification of Vital Records Fees

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To be more efficient, the ACR is requesting to change the Ordinance to refer to the California Department of Public Health's determination of these fees. This change would result in a public benefit by saving the administrative costs of periodically reapproving fees in a County public hearing that have already been determined by the California Department of Public Health. The dollar amount will be correctly reflected on the Fee Schedule as a course of normal business.

Restrictive Covenants Modification Program Fee

With the passing of AB 1466 and the subsequent creation of Government Code section 27388.2, the County recorder may impose a \$2.00 fee on each real estate instrument, paper, or notice. The funds generated by this fee shall be used only by the County recorder collecting the fee for the purpose of implementing a restrictive covenants program. Creation of a subfund is necessary to track applicable revenue and expenditures. Pursuant to Government Code section 27388.2(c), the County recorder shall not charge this fee after December 31, 2027, unless it has received reauthorization by the Board of Supervisors. The County recorder shall not seek reauthorization of the fee by the Board before June 1, 2027, or after December 31, 2027. Any reauthorization period shall not exceed five (5) years.

The Restricted Covenant Modification (RCM) Program seeks to hasten the removal of the offensive covenants in three (3) ways:

- 1. The bill requires all county recorders throughout the state to establish an RCM program to identify and redact unlawfully restrictive covenants and make regular reports on its progress to the Legislature.
- 2. The bill allows any person, not just an owner, to file an RCM with the county recorder's office if they have knowledge of the unlawful restriction.
- 3. The bill enables a person with an ownership interest to record an RCM by waiving fees and requires title companies, realtors, and specified others who know of such restriction to notify an owner or prospective owner of the existence of the restriction, and to inform them of their right to use the RCM process.

County recorders are required to perform the duties assigned under this measure, including tracking, and maintaining a record of homes with unlawfully restrictive covenants once they have been identified, even if the Board of Supervisors does not authorize the fee.

A pro forma version of the proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 729 has been attached as Exhibit A. The Office of County Counsel has approved the Ordinance amendments as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Upon Board approval of the proposed amendments to the Ordinance, the updates will be reflected on the ACR's fee schedule and made available to the public.
