BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside County District Attorney's Office Division of Victim Services funding will be used towards National Crime Victims' Rights Week. Three Candlelight Vigils that are held across Riverside County to remember the victims of crime. The mission is to empower victims and witnesses of crime through advocacy and support services while promoting successful prosecution
- 2. Cougar Country Football Boosters will use funding to pay for 60 football players to travel to Utah and play against the Dixie High School Football team followed by a trip to Utah Tech to watch a football game. The funding will cover two charter buses, hotel stay and all meals.
- 3. Moreno Valley Community Foundation funding will be used towards the MoVaLearns 2023-2024 program which helps 50 at-risk Moreno Valley College students with a monthly stipend, to earn while they learn while allowing students to finish their education and pursue the path towards a higher-paying career.
- 4. Beaumont Cherry Valley Recreation Park District funding will be used towards community events such as Movies Under the Stars and Oktoberfest events.
