BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) was created by the Crime Prevention Act of 2000 to provide a stable funding source for local juvenile justice programs anticipated to reduce crime and delinquency among at-risk youth; youth who have been released from a juvenile detention facility or who are under the supervision of the County of Riverside Probation Department, or any other youth as risk of becoming involved in juvenile delinquency.

The JJCPA funding has supported programs that resulted in lower crime rates among juveniles include intense family interventions, after-school programs for at-risk teens, gang and truancy prevention, job training and diversion programs. State law compels that counties provide programs that have been demonstrated to be effective in reducing delinquency.

In FY18/19, the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Counsel (JJCC) approved the Riverside County Probation Department to release a second round of Request for Proposal to expand services to community-based organizations to deliver services to youth who have been released from a juvenile detention facility, under supervision of the Riverside County Probation Department, or at risk of becoming involved in juvenile delinquency. Entities were asked to propose services known to reduce crime and recidivism to the identified population. To widen service options, the Riverside County Probation Department did not restrict the type of services eligible to be proposed which resulted in eleven awards.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Probation’s mission is “Serving Courts, Protecting Our Community, and Changing Lives.” The JJCPA program provides state funding for counties to implement programs that have proven effective in reducing crime and delinquency among at-risk youth and youthful offenders. The Riverside County Probation Department provides a collaborative and integrated multi-agency approach to early intervention services and programs which are effective in preventing and suppressing juvenile delinquency.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Riverside County Purchasing released a Request for Proposal (PRARC-RFP-000087) on behalf of the Probation Department. After the evaluation phase, contracts were awarded to Carolyn E. Wylie Center for Children, Student Nest, Riverside Art Museum, Raincross Boxing Academy,

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Play Vista (PV) Job, Living Advantage, Jay Cee Dee Children's Home, Inland SoCal 211+, Chavez Educational Services, Calicinto Ranch, and Big Brothers Big Sisters.

The original Professional Service Agreement became effective FY19/20 and was renewable in 1-year increments through written amendments for four (4) additional years. Due to the dollar value of these contracts, Board of Supervisors approval was not required. However, due to annual increases in line with the Consumer Pricing Index, the vendors are requesting an increase to the contract amounts as supported by the Probation Department. These amendments represent the final year for the period of performance.

This Amendment No. 4 to the Professional Service Agreement to provide Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) Funding, Probation Juvenile Program Services (hereinafter "Amendment No. 4") is made and entered into by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the state of California (hereinafter "COUNTY") and Carolyn E. Wylie Center for Children, Youth & Families, a California non-profit corporation (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR").

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that Service Agreement for Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) Funding, Probation Juvenile Program Services, effective February 3, 2020 (the "Service Agreement");

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that Amendment No. 1 to exercise the first of four options to renew the Service Agreement for a one-year period through June 30, 2021, for the budgeted amount of \$99,814; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that Amendment No. 2 to exercise the second of four options to renew the Service Agreement for a one-year period through June 30, 2022, for the budgeted amount of \$99,814; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that Amendment No. 3 to exercise the third of four options to renew the Service Agreement for a one-year period through June 30, 2023, for the budgeted amount of \$99,814; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of the Service Agreement provided for the renewal for up to four (4) additional terms of one (1) year each, at COUNTY'S sole option;

WHEREAS, Section 23.12 of the Service Agreement allows for modifications by written amendment signed by both parties; and,

WHEREAS, COUNTY elects to exercise its fourth option to renew the Service Agreement for an additional term of one (1) year to have CONTRACTOR continue

providing services, which commences on July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, with an amended budgeted amount of \$109,795.00, upon the terms and conditions as set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained hereafter, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree to amend the Services Agreement according to the terms and in the manner set forth herein:

1. **Recitals:** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The Service Agreement is hereby renewed and extended for an additional term of one (1) year, commencing on July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.
3. **Period of Performance:** The first sentence of section 2.1 of the Service Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: "This Agreement shall be effective upon signature of this Agreement by both parties and continues in effect through June 30, 2024."
4. **Scope of Services:** The sentence of section 3d of the Exhibit A Scope of Services (Riverside County Specifics) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: "All funding recipients will report out on related data outcomes as defined by the COUNTY's JJCPA Evaluation Services provider (WestEd) for all services provided."
5. Exhibit B (Budget) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit B-1
6. **Miscellaneous:** All other terms and conditions of the Service Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged.
7. **Effective Date.** This Amendment No. 4 shall become effective upon signature of both parties.

symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.
