BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution No. 2023-022 adopted May 9, 2023 as item 3.40, the Board of Supervisors gave notice of a public hearing for June 27, 2023, to receive testimony regarding the Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 158 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 158 will fund the maintenance and servicing of streetlights within public rights-of-way located Northerly of El Tecolote Road, Easterly of Sultanas Road, Southerly of Western View Drive, and Westerly of Pierson Road in the Romoland area and includes 16.78 acres.

The annexation of territory to an existing assessment district formed under the Landscaping and Lighting Act is a change of organization that requires a public hearing as part of the annexation process. Str. & H. Code §§ 22605(a), 22607, 22588; Gov't. Code § 53753(d).

On May 10, 2023 a notice of the public hearing and information sheet, a mail-in assessment ballot, an impartial analysis, and a copy of Resolution No. 2023-022 was mailed to all property owners within Street Lighting Zone 158, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all assessment ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2023-022 in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of Resolution No. 2023-022 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two (2) other public locations within the County.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The new assessment is for the purpose of providing the maintenance and servicing of streetlights within public right-of-way.

Only the commercial property owners within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 158, which are represented by Parcel Map No. 37787 & Plot Plan No. 190035, as described in the attached Exhibit "A" (a two-page exhibit containing a description and diagram)

are impacted by the cost of this annexation. The property owners within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 158 have petitioned the County of Riverside to annex their property to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and understand that this annexation will result in an assessment on their property to fund the maintenance and servicing of the aforementioned improvements (streetlights).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2023-24 for Street Lighting Zone 158 is \$1,288. This will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2023-24 within Street Lighting Zone 158 of \$77 per acre. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for electricity (CPI-U_Electricity), if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2023.


