BACKGROUND:

Summary

Resolution No. 2023-167 is needed as an addendum to Resolution No. 2011-246 to clarify that the Human Resources Director has the delegated authority under Government Code Section 21173 to make disability retirement applications to CalPERS on behalf of all employees. This Resolution includes both industrial and non-industrial applications. Resolution No. 2011-246 authorized the County of Riverside to file disability retirement applications with CalPERS but did not specifically include language that the Human Resources Director has the delegated authority to file those applications on behalf of the County of Riverside.

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9 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside (herein referred to as Agency) is a contracting
10 agency of the California Public Employees' Retirement System;

11 WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency
12 determine whether an employee of such agency in employment, whether a local safety member or a
13 miscellaneous member, is disabled for purposes of the Public Employees' Retirement Law and whether
14 such disability is "industrial" within the meaning of such Law; and

15 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined upon legal advice that it may, under
16 Sections 21152 and 21173 of the Government Code, delegate authority to make such determinations to
17 the incumbent of the office/position of Human Resources Director;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the
19 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, in regular session assembled on July 11, 2023 at 9:30am
20 or soon thereafter in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors located on the 1st floor of the County
21 Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, that the Board of Supervisors of the
22 County of Riverside hereby delegates to the incumbent of the office/position of Human Resources
23 Director the authority to make disability retirement applications for all employees of the County of
24 Riverside, on behalf of the Agency, pursuant to Government Code section 21152 (c) for disability
25 retirement of stated employees.




