(In response to 4th District Supervisors verbal statements on Item: 4.44 of the July 11, 2023 Board of Supervisors meeting)

Dear Riverside County current Representatives,

This written response was necessary to combat Supervisor Perez's (fourth District Supervisor) unfounded and misconstrued verbal comments in the matter of the July 11, 2023 Board of Supervisors meeting agenda Item: 4.44 (Carver Track, use of ARPA funds – 3.5 Million dollars)

It's concerning that Public testimony from this Riverside County Resident (Brad Anderson) was used by Supervisor Perez to potentially drive untrue comparisons between the City of Rancho Mirage and the area of Carver Track (located between the City of Indio and the City of Coachella). Please be absolutely aware that my concerns were on the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds being used for this very isolated area of unincorporated Riverside County, and the unadvertised "Sweetheart deal(s)" that may exist between parties that financially benefit from that project.

Please consider, that areas of the City of Rancho Mirage (my current community) has NO sidewalks. And I prefer that over having more concrete/constructed heat retaining surfaces near my home and other negative consequences of property maintenance and liabilities of installed hard surfaces. Supervisor Perez made selective reference to Public safety in regards to the "Carver Track" project for what appears to be only political theater, but lacks any true aspects in regards to the true goal of securing Public resources for that small neighborhood that Mr. Perez openly talked about having generational family connections with. It's reasonable that potential conflicts of interest would exist with Mr. Perez having family connections with Carver Track project beneficiaries.

The Carver Track area has No Community Council commission established through Riverside County, like most other unincorporated communities of the fourth District that have established Community Councils. It's reasonable to consider that the Carver Track area (Residents) had decided not to participate with other Cities or Riverside County to Improve their infrastructure over the years. And any "Neglect" (as stated by Mr. Perez) was allowed to exist by "All" current and former Fourth District Supervisors and Riverside County officials over the years.

In summary, The Carver Track has been fast tracked for Improvements of its infrastructure. And such fast tracking will be at the direct costs to all Americans (ARPA Funds) – those actions were due to the influence of Riverside County official (Supervisor Perez) and his direct (potential conflict of interest) with Carver Track resident's. It's disappointing that Mr. Perez made untrue comparisons between Coachella Valley communities for yet to be determined reasonable reasons.
