BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- **1. The FIATM Group, Inc. \$3,000** funding will be used to support the Tutoring Education All Creating Hope (T.E.A.C.H.) Program that will assist youth within the communities by promoting a good value system, citizenship and increasing the high school graduation rate to universities.
