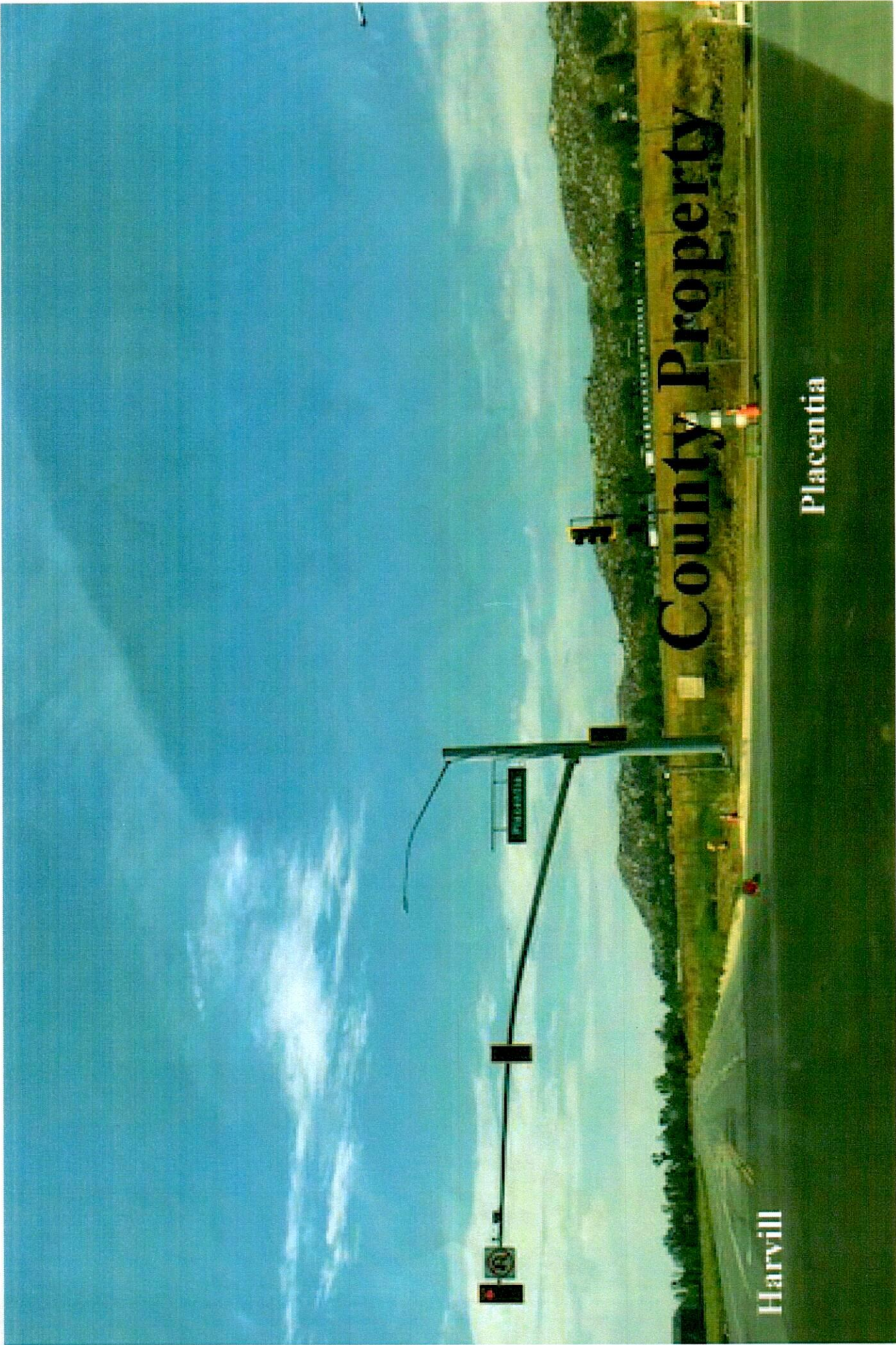

Ca Constitution ART XIII SEC 35

(1) Public safety services are critically important to the security and well-being of the State's citizens and to the growth and revitalization of the State's economic base. **(2)** The protection of the public safety is the first responsibility of local government and local officials have an obligation to give priority to the provision of adequate public safety services. **(3)** In order to assist local government in maintaining a sufficient level of public safety services, the proceeds of the tax enacted pursuant to this section shall be designated exclusively for public safety.
