- 3. Authorize \$1,000,000 from District 2 2nd ARPA allocation, to be obligated for Housing, Homelessness and Workforce Development for the Youth Employment, Youth Corps and RCCD Early Childhood Education Certificate programs.

#### BACKGROUND:

### **Summary**

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 (H.R. 1319) in to law. The \$1.9 trillion package is intended to combat the COVID-19 pandemic, including the public health and economic impacts.

As part of the \$362 billion in federal fiscal recovery aid for state and local governments, \$65.1 billion is provided in direct aid to counties. Riverside County's share of the American Rescue Plan funding is \$479,874,599, of which the first installment of \$239,937,299 was received on May 10, 2021, and the second installment in the same amount was received on June 6, 2022. The funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026.

On October 4, 2022, the Board of Supervisors approved the ARPA 2<sup>nd</sup> installment funding allocation which allocated \$33 million per district to be obligated towards infrastructure, housing and homelessness, workforce development, neighborhood revitalization, business revitalization, childcare facilities, and non-profits.

District 2 continues the process of prioritizing and identifying eligible projects, to be delivered by County Departments and external agencies and is requesting to obligate an additional of \$3,361,499 from its remaining 2<sup>nd</sup> ARPA allocations to the below eligible ARPA projects:

- Home Gardens Library Refresh OED \$361,499
- Temescal Road Widening Improvements TLMA \$2,000,000
- Workforce Development HWS \$1,000,000 and including:
  - o Youth Employment Program \$400,000
  - Youth Corps- \$400,000
  - o RCCD Norco Campus- Early Childhood Education Certificate \$200,000

The County lead departments shall be returning to the Board in the future with actions to implement the projects referenced above and with the related budget adjustments.
