**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- **1. Inland Empire Buffalo Soldiers Heritage Association \$1,000** will be used to assist the Association provide a Thanksgiving Dinner for veteran families this holiday season.
- 2. Family Service Association \$5,000 will be used to support the "HOPE for the Holidays" program that provides foster children and youth with a toy, a warm blanket, essential toiletries, and a duffle bag to tote their belongings with integrity in a difficult period of life.
- 3. Riverside University Health System Foundation \$6,000 will be used to fund critical work at RUHS Pediatrics, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, and the Child Abuse and Neglect Unit.
- **4. Assistance League of Temecula Valley \$2,500** will be used to support the 5 Point program, which provides new, school appropriate clothing & shoes for students K-12 attending school districts within the First District.
