

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Salute to Veterans Parade Committee - \$1,000.00 The funding will be used to support operations for the Veterans Day Parade in Riverside.
2. Treasure Box Angels - \$1,000.00 The funding will be used for the Christmas Wish Tree Program that will help with food and holiday gifts for ill children at Loma Linda Hospital.
3. Family Services Association - \$4,000.00 The funds will be utilized for the HOPE for the Holidays Program to provide children, ages 0-18, who are in foster care with gifts and essential items during the holiday season.
4. City of Menifee - \$2,000.00 The funding will be used to sponsor the Menifee State of the City Event, which brings civic leaders, residents, and businesses together to celebrate accomplishments and acknowledge the future of Menifee for the community.
5. Temecula Sunrise Rotary Foundation - \$2,500.00 The funds will be utilized for the Temecula Community Christmas Dinner, approximately 1,000 people in attendance. In addition, 300 meals will be delivered to homebound seniors in the community.
6. Assistance League of Temecula Valley - \$5,000.00 The funds will be used for the Five-Points Program, which will provide Aldi 'food-only' gift cards to be distributed to families in the Murrieta and Temecula School Districts to focus on children in Title 1 schools.
7. Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center - \$1,000.00 The funding will be utilized for their annual fundraising event, which supports youth, parents and educators through awareness and prevention services.
