

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside National Cemetery Memorial Honor Detail - \$2,000** will be used to assist with the maintenance and operations of the Riverside National Cemetery.
2. **Restoring Hope Community Services, Inc. - \$2,000** will be used to support the cost for food, clothing, and job training for veterans and families dealing with homelessness.
3. **Inlandia Institute - \$2,000** will be used to support the cost for a ASL interpreter for the creative writing and cultural enrichment workshops.
