5 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
6 THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE EXTENDING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE  
7 TO HURRICANE HILARY

9 WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8630, Article 14, of the California Emergency Services  
10 Act requires that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside review, at least every thirty (30)  
11 days until such Local Emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the Local Emergency; and

12 WHEREAS, a period of Local Emergency presently exists in the County of Riverside in  
13 accordance with the proclamation thereof by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, by  
14 Resolution No. 2023-244 as a result of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property  
15 within said county, caused by the storm system driven by Hurricane Hilary which took place within the  
16 County of Riverside, through power outages; flooding; mudflows; road and school closures; debris  
17 removal; swift water rescues; major communication system failure; damage to public and private  
18 infrastructure; and

19 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside has reviewed the need to  
20 continue the existence of the Local Emergency; and

21 WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said condition of extreme peril is still deemed necessary;  
22 now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby  
24 proclaim the extension of the period of Local Emergency for thirty (30) additional days unless sooner  
25 terminated.

26 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue-to exist  
27 until its termination is proclaimed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.
