### **RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 2. Ratify and approve the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) Grant awarded by the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) for projects of the Western Region of Riverside County, in the amount of \$75,000 for grant cycle 1, commencing April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2024 ("Grant"); and
- 3. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Agreements on behalf of the County; and
- 4. Authorize the Riverside County Office on Aging (RCOoA) Director, or designee, to take all necessary steps to administer the Grant and sign any other forms, certifications, assurances, reports, or other documents related to the Grant and required by CNCS to effectuate the Grant, as approved as to form by County Counsel and that is consistent with the Board's approval;
- 5. Adopt Resolution No. 2023-279, Approving the authorization for the RCOoA Director, or designee, to be charged with the responsibility of administering and implementing the RSVP Grant Program for the duration of the resolution to:
  - a) Apply for Grants annually administered by CNCS for both the eastern and western regions of Riverside County; and,
  - b) Accept funding annually in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for each region of Riverside County (eastern and western), if the County receives funds as a result to applying for a CNCS Grant; and,
  - Execute Grant agreements and subrecipient agreements, approved as to form by County Counsel, as a result to applying for a CNCS Grant; and.
  - d) Sign Grant amendments and subrecipient agreements, approved as to form by County Counsel, that (a) make modifications to the scope of work that stay within the intent of the Grant Agreement, and/or (b) make modifications to the compensation provisions to fulfill the requirements of the Grant Agreement, not to exceed thirty percent (30%) of the total Grant.

#### BACKGROUND:

#### Summary

For over 20 years, the Riverside County Office on Aging (RCOoA) has administered the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP), which provides an opportunity for individuals 55 years and older to volunteer and share their experience to assist local public and non-profit agencies. RSVP operates as a conduit for senior volunteer recruitment, retention, and recognition, serving

as a vital link between volunteers and RCOoA's community-centered goals. By placing these individuals in volunteer roles within community-based organizations, RSVP facilitates a synergy that benefits both volunteers and the communities they serve. Through these volunteer positions, participants can leverage their skills, knowledge, and passion to enact positive change and enhance the well-being of their communities.

#### Western Region RSVP Program:

RCOoA's Western Region RSVP program will have an estimated 175 volunteers that will serve the service area attached to this project. Of this number, 100 RSVP volunteers will be placed in outcome assignments. The primary focus area of this project is Disaster Services with a workplan that focuses on two (2) objectives, which are for RSVP Volunteers to aid communities and senior centers as they recover from COVID-19 and preparing vulnerable and isolated older adults who do not have access to educational training material and resources related to disaster preparedness. At the end of the three-year grant cycle, it is expected that at least 60 RSVP Volunteers will be placed in a disaster services work plan.

#### Eastern Region RSVP Program:

RCOoA's Eastern Region RSVP Program proposes to have at least 450 AmeriCorps Senior volunteers who will assist with local food pantries and companionship activities. These activities are designed to increase social support for homebound older adults and individuals with disabilities to increase their capacity for independent living and provide evidence-based physical fitness and education classes that support fall prevention. Volunteers provide evidence-based fitness classes in community centers, senior centers, and faith-based organizations. At the end of the three-year grant cycle, AmeriCorps Senior volunteers will have placed at least 55 volunteers at 25 food banks, food pantries, and senior community centers.

In light of the recent pandemic-related changes and returning to standard operations, the program underwent modifications to ensure the safety and effectiveness of its volunteer placements. This resulted in adjustments to the program's application timeline for seeking Board approval for the RSVP Grant, a necessary step to secure the continuation of its vital initiatives. Ratification of this Grant ensures that the RSVP Program can continue operations and receive necessary funding to support its community-oriented initiatives.

RCOoA remains dedicated to the success of the RSVP Program and the impactful contributions it makes to our community.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

RSVP offers volunteer recruitment, retention and recognition in Riverside County. The program's mission is to place older adults, aged 55 years and older, into volunteer positions within community-based organizations and local municipalities throughout Riverside County.

With multi-year projects, CNCS makes an initial award for the first grant term of the project period, and additional funding for subsequent years is contingent upon satisfactory progress and the availability of funding. For the first year of the project period, the local share will be provided by community partners and local program support. The CNCS federal investment of \$75,000 will be supplemented by at least \$22,500 (30% match requirment) in Year 3 of nonfederal resources. The AmeriCorps investment of \$68,582 will be supplemented by \$13,717 (20% match requirment). This match requirment is already accounted for in the department's budget.

WHEREAS, the Corporation for National and Community Service (the "Grantor") has awarded the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) Grant for projects in the Eastern and Western Region of Riverside County, for the period of April 1, 2021 - March 31, 2025 (the "Grant"); and,

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, Department of the Office on Aging (the "Department") is the designated Administrative Entity for the RSVP Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the Department may accept grant awards for the RSVP Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the RSVP Standard Agreement, Program regulations and requirements, and other contracts between the Department, the Grantor and grant recipients; and,

WHEREAS, the RSVP Grant serves the purpose of engaging older adults as volunteers to meet critical community needs, including but not limited to support for seniors and persons with disabilities; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, Department of the Office on Aging desires to apply for RSVP Program Grants, accept grant funding as a result to applying for a CNCS Grant, execute the Standard Agreement and any subsequent

amendments or modifications, as approved as to form by County Counsel and consistent with the Board of Supervisors' approval; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ("Board") in regular session assembled on October 17, 2023, at 9:30 a.m. or soon thereafter, in the meeting room located on the first floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, that this Board hereby authorizes the Director of the Department, or designee, to accept future grant funding related to the RSVP program and execute any agreements and amendments associated with such funding;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED that if the County of Riverside, Department of the Office on Aging receives an RSVP Grant from the CNCS, it represents and certifies that it will use all such funds in a manner consistent and in compliance with all applicable state and federal statutes, rules, regulations, and laws, including without limitation all rules and laws regarding the RSVP Program, as well as any and all contracts the County of Riverside, Department of the Office on Aging may have with subrecipients.
