BACKGROUND:

Summary

As a requirement of the Federal Qualified Health Center (FQHC) designation from the U. S. Department Health and Human Services, the County must have a governing board for the RUHS Community Health Centers. The Community Health Center Board (CHCB) was established by County Ordinance 751 in 1996. The CHCB presently has nine (9) to twenty-five (25) positions of which a majority must be users of services at the Community Health Centers. While the members as a whole must also be broadly representative of the characteristics of the population served by the FQHCs, certain positions are reserved for representatives of the County departments that work most directly with the CHCs to ensure integration of effort on behalf of the CHCs.

The individuals listed below applied to, and have been reviewed by the CHCB Board for renewal of their membership on the CHCB:

Patient Representative

Greg Rodriguez is the Deputy Director of Economic Development within Riverside County. Since he has served as the CHC Board Chairman, he has utilized his knowledge of Riverside County's demographics to best serve the community. Greg would like to continue to lead the CHC Board ethically and efficiently.

Patient Representative

Arnold Tabuenca, MD is currently Riverside University Health System's Associate Chief Medical Officer. His unique perspective dealing with patient care enables him to advocate for patients. He is eager to continue participating on the CHC Board for another term.

Patient Representative

Richard Rajaratnam, MD , FRCS, FACS has many years of experience within the medical field as the Chief Integration Officer for Loma Linda University Health.
