

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Southern California Black Chamber of Commerce - \$1,000.00 The funds will be used to sponsor the 30<sup>th</sup> Year Celebration of the Southern California Black Chamber of Commerce. In addition, the Chamber is hosting a Mergers and Acquisitions Conference bringing together stakeholders, the business community, and the general public.
2. Animal Friends of the Valleys - \$11,000.00 The funding will be utilized for the Senior Medical Grant for residents in the Third District, which assists low-income seniors to provide medical care for their animals.
3. Boy Scouts of America - \$1,000.00 The funds will be used to sponsor the Tahquitz Distinguished Citizen Event, which is a fundraiser for low-income families for their children to participate in the Boy Scouts Program.
4. The Wildomar Community and Parks Foundation - \$6,000.00 The funding will be utilized for an overall cleanup and beautification of public areas in the Wildomar community.
5. NAMI Mount San Jacinto - \$2,500.00 The funds will be used to sponsor the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual NAMI Walks Inland Empire at Diamond Valley Lake, which supports 'Family to Family'

program for family members of persons with mental health diagnosis, and the 'Peer to Peer' program that provides education to people with a mental health diagnosis.

6. Future Leaders of Tomorrow - \$1,500.00 The funding will be utilized to sponsor the 'Holiday Blankets and Cheer for the Community' program, which supports underprivileged children and homeless individuals in the Third District.
