

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside Educational Enrichment Foundation - \$2,000** will be used to enhance the educational experience of John W. North students in performing arts.
- 2. Southern California Railway Museum Inc. - \$5,000** funds will be utilized to provide essential supplies and activities for students in grades K-12, as well as to support the maintenance and operations of the museum.
- 3. NAMI Mt. San Jacinto - \$2,000** will be used to assist with the organization in providing services and supports to families affected by mental illness.
