BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Sheriff's Office (RSO) currently occupies 51,000 square feet in the county-owned building located at 1500 Castellano Road in Jurupa Valley (Current Facility). The building serves as an administrative headquarters for specialized patrol divisions and investigation teams including the Special Investigations Bureau. RSO desires to reduce its footprint to approximately 35,000 square feet in the city of Riverside. Due to age, the Current Facility is in need of substantial renovation and is no longer efficient for the RSO to operate.

Facilities Management (FM) concurs that there is no suitable County-owned space available for occupancy in the Downtown Riverside area. The estimated RSO facility space need is approximately 35,000 square feet, capable of accommodating 150 staff members, a secured parking area with 180 parking spaces, a loading dock with large doors, a warehouse storage area, and office space.

Through this action the Board of Supervisors (Board) is authorizing FM Real Estate (FM-RE) to begin the process to locate and lease space in the Downtown Riverside area and on behalf of RSO. FM-RE will return to the Board once they have a fully negotiated lease agreement for consideration by the Board.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The new desired location will be conveniently located within the downtown Riverside area and near existing County administrative offices. The impact on residents and businesses will be positive.
