BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

The Self-Sufficiency Division of DPSS currently occupies 25,038 square feet of space in two separate buildings at 68-615 Perez Road, and 68-625 Perez Road, in the City of Cathedral City. Women, Infants, and Children Nutrition Program (WIC) currently occupies 3,089 square feet of space in one facility at 68-615 Perez Road in the City of Cathedral City. These DPSS leases are due to expire on October 31, 2024. The WIC lease is due to expire on June 14, 2026 and includes a right to terminate after June 14, 2025.

DPSS and WIC serve overlapping populations in Riverside County and colocation of the two agencies will align with the county's integrated services delivery initiative that supports the "No Wrong Door" approach for the community. These programs propose initiation of a search for potential sites within the Cathedral City area which can co-locate the two DPSS offices and WIC while occupying less square footage. FM-RE concurs, as indicated on the attached Endorsement, that no suitable county-owned space is available in this area. The agencies would consider a full range of available buildings in the community; however, the required space is estimated to be approximately 24,000 square feet, single story, capable of accommodating 134 staff.

Upon Board approval of the In Principle, a Request for Proposal (RFP) will be released. The RFP's will be evaluated, and a site selection will be made. FM-RE will negotiate the terms of the lease and any tenant improvements before the lease will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Consolidating locations in this community will optimize delivery of vital DPSS and WIC services while saving operating costs.

Additional Fiscal Information

No additional County funds will be required.
