BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("DISTRICT") has requested the acceptance of portions of Read Street and Steele Peak Drive to facilitate the Good Hope - Olive Avenue Storm Drain Project ("PROJECT"). The PROJECT plans to provide flood control and drainage improvements to address drainage concerns in the Good Hope community. The PROJECT also includes road improvements to certain unimproved sections of Read Street and Steele Peak Drive. This acceptance will enable the DISTRICT to install their facilities and construct improvements by encroachment permit and bring the improved sections of Read Street and Steele Peak Drive into the County Maintained Road system, subject to improvements in accordance with County Standards. Read Street and Steele Peak Drive (formerly Orange Avenue) were dedicated but not accepted for public road purposes by "Mountain Glen Tract", on file in Book 11, page 520 of Maps, Records of San Diego County, California. The Transportation Department recommends approval of this acceptance.

As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the acceptance of the roadways is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) and Not a Project pursuant to Section 15060(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The acceptance will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

County Counsel has approved resolution Number 2023-247 as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The acceptance of the roadway portions will not impact residents or businesses.

Additional Fiscal Information

All fees are paid by the applicant. There is no General Fund obligation.

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Name of Public Agency Approving Project: Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project: David L. McMillan, Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Exempt Status: California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The acceptance of a street has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The acceptance of the existing roadway will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. The acceptance of this street will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is
no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the
environment. The acceptance of a street will not require any construction activities,
change the use or intensity of the existing site to create a physical environmental impact,

- and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would accepting of a street have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the acceptance is exempt from further CEQA analysis.
- Section 15060(c) for purposes of analysis under CEQA, accepting a street is not a
 "project" under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c). An action by a public agency is
 only a "project" subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change in the
 environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or
 authorized by the County, in no way will accepting a street increase the use of the site,
 result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct, indirect,
 or cumulative physical environmental impacts.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.





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
