#### BACKGROUND:

#### Summary

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 (H.R. 1319) into law. The \$1.9 trillion package is intended to combat the COVID-19 pandemic, including the public health and economic impacts.

As part of the \$362 billion in federal fiscal recovery aid for state and local governments, \$65.1 billion is provided in direct aid to counties. Riverside County's share of the ARPA funding is \$479,874,599, of which the first installment of \$239,937,299 was received on May 10, 2021, and the second installment in the same amount was received on June 6, 2022. The funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026.

On October 4, 2022, (Agenda Item 3.44) the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved the ARPA second installment funding allocation which distributed \$33 million per district to be obligated towards infrastructure, housing and homelessness, workforce development, neighborhood revitalization, business revitalization, childcare facilities, and non-profits.

On August 29, 2023, (Agenda Item 3.3) the Board approved \$3,361,499 from the 2<sup>nd</sup> District's second ARPA allocation to various County Departments, of which \$2,000,000 was authorized for design and environmental cost associated with the ultimate widening of Temescal Canyon Road from north of El Cerrito Road to Tom Barnes Street.

This item is to authorize the use of ARPA funds for the project stated above in an amount of \$2,000,000 as a response to the Board's agenda on August 29, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.3), and to approve the budget adjustment. Future items will be brought before the Board for construction advertisement and construction contract award.
