

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Dresses & Dreams Project - \$1,500** will be used to support efforts to provide dresses to local high school girls that are going through hardships or circumstances which leave them unable to purchase a formal dress and accessories to attend their prom. 100-120 girls are expected to sign up for assistance this year.
  
2. **Martin Luther King High School, “King High Remembers” - \$1,000** will be used to provide assistance with costs of the King High Remembers program, a Veterans Oral History Project.
  
3. **Allen Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church - \$1,500** will be used to provide food and clothing for homeless and underserved population for the holidays.
