BACKGROUND:

Summary

At the request of the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD), Riverside County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) is bringing forth this joint resolution to accept funds for both the Transitional Housing Program (THP) and Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program (HNMP).

Transitional Housing Program: THP services help young adults who are 18 to 25 years of age to secure and maintain housing by increasing their life skills, reducing the waitlist for housing and providing linkage to community services for emancipated young adults. DPSS is currently providing Transitional Housing Program-Plus (THP-Plus) services to a caseload of 41 emancipated young adults.

The Board of Supervisors previously approved the first round of THP funding (for FY 19/20) from HCD to DPSS at the May 19, 2020 Board meeting (Agenda Item No. 3.27). A second round of funding in the amount of \$257,600 was approved at the October 27, 2020 Board of Supervisors meeting (Agenda Item 3.14). A third round of funding in the amount of \$257,600 was approved at the January 25, 2022 Board of Supervisors meeting (Agenda Item 3.42). A fourth round of funding in the amount of \$1,291,873 was approved at the January 31, 2023 Board of Supervisors meeting (Agenda Item 3.15). The HCD has allocated a fifth round of funding in the amount of \$1,411,920 to DPSS for THP services. This funding is to be expended by June 30, 2026.

Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program: HNMP funding is used for housing navigators to act as housing specialists to assist young adults between the ages of 18-21 to secure and maintain housing. Priority is given to young adults in foster care. The funding will assist with case management, preventative measures to protect youth from homelessness and assist youth with linkages to community resources. 80 to 100 young adults are expected to receive services with this funding.

The Board of Supervisors previously approved the first round of HNMP funding (for FY 22/23) from HCD to DPSS at the January 31, 2023 Board of Supervisors meeting (Agenda Item No.

3.15). HCD has allocated a second round of funding in the amount of \$863,470 to Riverside County DPSS for the HNMP program. This funding is to be expended by June 30, 2026.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This funding will ensure that young adults between the ages of 18 to 25 secure and maintain safe and stable housing.

Additional Fiscal Information

This must be expended by June 30, 2026. No General Fund match is required for receipt of these funds. The Transitional Housing Program and Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program are 100% funded through State funds.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING AND DELEGATING TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SOCIAL SERVICES, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT THE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM COUNTY ALLOCATION ROUND 5 AWARD, TO ACCEPT THE HOUSING NAVIGATION AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM COUNTY ALLOCATION ROUND 2 AWARD, AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED OR DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER THESE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") issued an allocation acceptance form to the County of Riverside ("County"), dated October 19, 2023, under Round 5 of the Transitional Housing Program ("THP"), authorized by item 2240-102-0001 of section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2023 (Chapter 12 of the Statutes of 2023) and Chapter 11.7 (commencing with Section 50807) of part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code ("THP Allocation Acceptance Round 5 Form"); and,

WHEREAS, HCD issued an allocation acceptance form to the County, dated October 19, 2023, under Round 2 of the Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program ("HNMP"), authorized by Item 2240-103-0001 of Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2023 (Chapter 12 of the Statutes of 2023) and Chapter 11.8 (commencing with Section 50811) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code (the "HNMP Allocation Acceptance Round 2 Form"); and,

WHEREAS, the THP Allocation Acceptance Round 5 Form and the HNMP Allocation Acceptance Round 2 Form are collectively referred to as the "Allocation Acceptance Forms"; and,

WHEREAS, the Allocation Acceptance Forms relate to the availability and use of the funds under

both the THP and HNMP Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED, by the County Board of Supervisors ("Board") in regular session assembled on December 12, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. or soon thereafter, in the meeting room located on the first floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, that this Board does hereby determine and declare as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, to accept the County's allocated \$1,411,920 award, as detailed in the THP Allocation Acceptance Round 5 Form, by way of executing said form.

SECTION 2. That the Board hereby affirms that if additional THP funds become available to the County, the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, to accept the funds ("Additional THP Allocation") up to the amount awarded by HCD, but not to exceed \$2,823,840 in additional funding, by executing all necessary forms.

SECTION 3. That the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, to accept the County's allocated \$863,470 award, as detailed in the HNMP Allocation Acceptance Round 2 Form, by way of executing said form.

SECTION 4. The Board hereby affirms that if additional HNMP funds become available to the County, the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, to accept the funds ("Additional HNMP Allocation") up to the amount awarded by HCD, but not to exceed \$1,726,940 in additional funding, by executing all necessary forms.

SECTION 5. That the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, to act on behalf of the County in connection with the Transitional Housing Program by executing all required additional HCD forms or documents to participate in or administer the Transitional Housing Program.

SECTION 6. That the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, to act on behalf of the County in connection with the Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program by executing all required additional HCD forms or documents to participate in or administer the Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program.

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SECTION 7. That DPSS shall be subject to the terms and conditions that are specified in the Allocation Acceptance Forms, and that DPSS will use these funds in accordance with said terms and conditions, and any subsequent amendments or amendment thereto, as well as any and all other THP and HNMP requirements, or other applicable laws.

SECTION 8. That the Board authorizes and delegates authority to the Director of DPSS, or designee, with the discretion to accept both the THP and HNMP program funds as detailed herein but, in the event that one of the two allocations are not made available for DPSS or DPSS opts not to receive one of the allocations, DPSS is authorized to accept either of the allocations independent of each other.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED that this Board hereby authorizes this resolution to take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The allocation excludes Alpine and Mono counties because their calculation did not demonstrate need. The housing navigation and maintenance program for a county that accepts an allocation of money pursuant to this section shall provide training to its child welfare agency social workers and probation officers who serve nonminor dependents. The training shall address an overview of the housing resources available through the local coordinated entry system, homeless continuum of care, and county public agencies, including, but not limited to, housing navigation, permanent affordable housing, THP-Plus, and housing choice vouchers. The training shall also address how to access and receive a referral to existing housing resources, the social worker's and probation officer's role in identifying unstable housing situations for youth, and referring youth to housing assistance programs.
