#### BACKGROUND:

# **Summary**

The requested Board action will approve receipt and filing of the Riverside University Health System Medical Center (RUHS-MC) report on Agreements and Purchases of Medical and Surgical Equipment and Supplies signed under Delegated Authority for the first quarter of fiscal year 2023/2024, as required per Motion No. 2 of Resolution 116-2021. RUHS-MC continues to report agreements and purchases approved under each specific delegated authority. Incorporated into this Board action is a report of all the Agreements and purchases approved during the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2023/2024.

On July 21, 2015, Agenda Item Nos. 3.43 and 3.62 which served to delegate signature authority to the Assistant RUHS CEO and approve Resolution 2015-171, were approved by the Board.

On July 12, 2016, the Board approved Agenda Item No. 3.29, to renew Resolution 2016-157, which authorized the Purchasing Agent to initialize and implement Public Contract Code Section 20131, subsection (c), for procurements not to exceed \$750,000 per vendor, per twelve-month period.

On July 11, 2017, the Board approved Agenda Item No. 3.42 to renew resolution 2017-128, which authorized the Purchasing Agent to initialize and implement Public Contract Code Section 20131, subsection (c), for procurements not to exceed \$750,000 per vendor per twenty -four month period, through June 30, 2019.

On June 18, 2019, the Board approved Agenda Item No. 3.20 to renew resolution 2019-147, which authorized the Purchasing Agent to initialize and implement Public Contract Code Section 20131, subsection (c), for Procurements not to Exceed \$750,000 per Vendor per Year through June 30, 2021.

On June 15, 2021, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2021-116 to authorize the Purchasing Agent to make procurements not to exceed \$750,000 per vendor related to County hospital procurement procedures and activities until June 30, 2024.

RUHS-MC's primary objective in requesting the aforementioned Agenda items to be approved was to reduce wait times pertaining to processing of agreements deemed necessary for patient care. These agreements typically include equipment or medical supplies for patient services, initiate student internships, and generate new net revenue. The secondary objective was to remove items that are repetitive or routine and thus, help RUHS-MC streamline items being sent to the Board.

#### Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Delegated authority allows for patient services to be delivered faster and more efficiently. Those agreements that increase revenue or accelerate payments improve the hospital's fiscal health.
