BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the American Legion Norco Post 328 (\$3,500.00) will be used to support two programs, the Boys State scholarships and the Norco High School collegiate scholarships.
2. The donation to My Learning Studio OUTREACH (\$2,500.00) will be used for the Pardi Gras Pub Crawl which funds are used to offer free and fee-reduced tutoring for K-12 students who are disadvantaged, underserved and/or struggling academically and/or at-risk students of failing in the Second District.
3. The donation to Riverside County Department of Public Social Services, Adult Service Division (\$4,000.00) will be used for the 2024 Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Symposium.
4. The donation to Service Though Action (\$2,500.00) will be used for the Horse Town Brew n Que Festival which promotes community and raise funds that benefit healthy living, education and art programs.
5. The donation to Friends of the Inland Empire Lions (\$2,500.00) will be used for Adopt-a-Senior event in at the Eddie Dee Smith Senior Center.
6. The donation to Patriot High School Girls Soccer (\$2,000.00) will be used for the "Spirit Pack" and assistance with the end of the year banquet. The spirit pack includes practice shirts and a team jacket for all team members.
7. The donation to the Friends of the Corona Public Library (\$2,500.00) will be used for their annual Ladders & linguine dinner. All proceeds from this event go back to Library services and programs.
8. The donation to Corona-Norco Family YMCA (\$5,000.00) will be used for the YMCA Teen Center Scholarship Program which has been providing services in the Home Gardens neighborhood for over 26 years.
9. The donation to Corona-Norco Family YMCA / Fender Music Program (\$2,500.00) will be used for the Fender Music Scholarship program which provides hands-on performing art lessons to strengthen creativity, personal respect, and youth achievements. No child ages 5-17 is turned away for inability to pay for quality music lessons.
10. The donation to Hands and Feet Ministries (\$1,000.00) will help continue to offer a safe and inviting community for senior woman who are experiencing homelessness or are at

11. The donation to SAFE Family Justice Centers (\$3,000.00) will be used for Mardii Gras which proceeds will go to client services including safety planning, restraining order assistance, emergency stability funds, therapy, court assistance, housing and other services their clients need.
