**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

To maintain and enhance community relationships between the public and the public safety, Supervisor Gutierrez recommends the allocation of \$3,000 from District 5's CID funds to City of Beaumont's Police Department.

The purpose of these funds will be used for the 2023 Shop with a Cop Event. The City of Beaumont and the City of Banning partnered to host a Shop with a Cop event. This event included 20 students from Banning Unified School District and 20 students from Beaumont Unified School District. Each child received a \$125 gift card to shop at Walmart with a police officer. The event helped build relationships between the community, city, county, and police department.
